Hi Rekha,

On Saturday morning we were woken up about 12:45 a.m. by the loud noise of Tiki Hut customers outside in the sitting area. On Sunday morning at 01:10, we were once again woken up by the noise of taxis arriving, customers leaving the Tiki Lounge and people talking outside in the seating area.

As we have said previously, we understood that the licensing hours stopped at 12:00 p.m. at the weekends. We and many other residents close to the ever expanding nightlife of Earlsdon do not need these issues. We have put up and fought against them for many years now and this once again this shows that any extension to licensing hours to a premises in a residential area impacts greatly on people who are actually living here.

Could you please show this to the decision makers at the hearing?

Hi,

We were woken up at 12:20 a.m. this morning (Tuesday 30th January) by loud shouts and screams outside our front bedroom in Earlsdon Street caused by loutish drunks coming out of the Tiki Hut Bar in Earlsdon Street. There were fights in the road caused by young lads who could not hardly walk because they were so drunk. Two of the thugs came into our neighbours garden and dragged out a wheelie bin on to the road. Scuffles and fights continued. I joined one of our neighbour's outside to watch the idiots continue to cause trouble. Revellers were still coming out of the Tiki Hut while this was happening. Even after the recent visit by Coventry licensing officers at the bar to discuss the reported problems, nothing has changed.

I phoned the Coventry Council Noise Team at 12:45 a.m. on 02476832222 to report this disturbance.

This is a continuation of the major problems that this residential area experienced with the Cottage/Weatherspoons. Earlsdon Street is less than 200 yards long, yet more and more retail properties are being granted alcohol licenses and continue to cause issues with what was once a quiet residential suburb.

We would be grateful if you please help our neighbours and us by having a serious discussion and sorting this out with the proprietors of the Tiki Hut Bar and by not granting further licenses in Earlsdon Street?
