I am giving this certificate because I am of the opinion that other procedures under the Licensing Act are inappropriate in this case, because⁴:

There has been serious disorder this weekend (31st August - 1st September 2018) which emanated from this premises. This disorder has resulted in a fatal stabbing of a 21 year old male and a stabbing of another male which has left him in a life changing condition. I have serious concerns that if this premises remains open further disorder and serious violence will occur. This is a venue that attracts individuals from across the Country, therefore just because a
