The grounds to this review are under the licensing objective:

PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER AND PUBLIC SAFETY.

On Monday 3rd September 2018 West Midlands Police submitted paperwork requesting an expedited review of the Premises Licence for Club M, Hertford Place, Coventry. The request followed a large disorder outside the premises which resulted in two males being stabbed. One of the males received a stab wound which proved fatal. The second male received stab wounds to the abdomen and has multiple injuries as a result. This disorder took place at approximately 05:20hrs on Saturday 1st September 2018. Prior to this incident the Police received three logs to the premises reporting varying degrees of disorder. At 03:08hrs a female reported that she had been threatened with violence inside the club unless she handed over her mobile phone which she did. At 03:23hrs the same female contacted Police again stating she had received her phone back and no longer needed them. At 04:18hrs Police were contacted via the Council Control Room to disorder where a large group of males with weapons were trying to gain entry to the club having been refused entry. Police attended and following a foot chase a male was detained for drugs offences; during this incident a Police vehicle was damaged and a door supervisor was assaulted however declined to complain. At 05:08hrs the Police received a call from the Council Control Room stating the males involved in disorder previously had returned and were causing disorder to the rear of the premises. Multiple logs were then received from 05:24hrs; these all reported disorder with a large number of males involved and/or reported a stabbing. Throughout the evening Club M have contacted the Council Control Room to request Police, there are no recorded logs directly to the Police.

The premise in question is a nightclub just outside the City Centre which currently operates until 5am. The premises were hosting a live performance by an artist known as 'Mr Eazi' who is a Nigerian singer song-writer who performs afrobeats (contemporary West African pop that marries global pop and hip-hop). This artist had performed previously at the venue (27/01/2018). The venue informed us of the artist performing which we approved as there had been no concerns raised from the previous event.

CCTV SUMMARY/UPDATE

Presently we can confirm opposing parties (2 + males) can be identified leaving Club M and then becoming involved in a large disorder at the side/rear of the premises. We can confirm that one of the males is seen to be in possession of a knife. CCTV does not show an effective dispersal of people from the vicinity of the Club or to the perimeter as per their conditions. SIA operatives can be seen in black at the side of the premises but can only be picked out via their armbands as it appears they have removed their fluorescent tabards.

History

Club M has historically been involved in serious disorder and were taken to review in 2016 where stringent conditions were placed on the premises and hours were reduced. A new management team were put in place in December 2016 which is the current team in charge of the premises. The DPS has provided weekly copies of incident reports, ejections and refusals; he has consistently worked with us on improvement measures and actions.

In the last six months there have been three reported stabbing incidents within close proximity to Club M; these have all occurred after 04:00hrs. On the 15/04/2018 a female stated she had been stabbed after leaving the nightclub and going home only to receive a phone call stating her mother had been assaulted at the Club; when the female returned she was involved in an argument at the side/rear of the premises and received a stab wound however could not identify who had stabbed her. The female declined to provide a statement; this incident occurred around 05:00hrs.

The second stabbing happened on 22/07/2018. A large disorder occurred outside the front doors of Club M at approximately 04:30hrs; it appears a group outside the premises have been goading people within the smoking area of the location. This has then escalated as people inside the location have exited the main doors to confront the situation; the security has managed to intervene and separate the parties ensuring there customers were taken back in to the club and closed the doors. Eventually these customers have forced their way out of the premises and been confronted almost immediately whereby a further large scale disorder has ensued and a male received a stab injury from a bladed weapon. The victim in this case required surgery to a stab wound in his abdomen but declined to make a complaint and returned to London where he resides. CCTV was obtained and reviewed by the Licensing Team. The management team of David Gaine, Jafric Kalinga and Shane Sahota attended the Police Station on the 02/08/2018 to discuss the incident with PS Witts, PC Healy and PC Flowers. They recounted the events of the evening and felt their actions were appropriate and justifiable given the circumstances. The Licensing Team pointed out some areas they felt improvements could be made these being:

- 1) A secure bin to dispose of bottles appropriately
- 2) A movable TV Bracket to be installed to allow security to monitor cameras without customers being able to view this.
- 3) An alternative exit route to be documented should the front door not be usable.
- 4) Staff to be trained in scene management and items to be made available to allow them to preserve a scene.

The management team agreed to these suggestions and PS Witts, PC Healy and PC Flowers attended Club M on 03/08/2018 and met with Jafric Kalinga and Shane Sahota whereby they looked at the available options for the premises around the agreed actions. Whilst at the location Shane asked if it was possible for him to loan side panel for their knife arch as one of the connections had eroded – this was laid out on the floor in the premises. We sourced this panel and arranged for the local neighbourhood team to drop it off during the evening to ensure they could utilise the knife arch.

On 29/08/2018 PC Healy and PC Flowers attended Club M and met with Jafric Kalinga and Shane Sahota, this was to formally sign the action plan and to ensure the actions had been implemented. The secure bottle bin was in place in the corridor and the CCTV monitor had been placed onto a movable bracket. Jafric stated the other two items had been completed and staff were aware of requirements, we agreed to revisit and speak to staff during opening hours to confirm this. During the visit Shane asked if it was possible to loan some knife wands to assist with searching on entry. This was agreed and arrangements were made to deliver these on 31/08/2018.

On 31/08/2018 PC Healy along with partners from the Council Licensing Team and SIA attended Club M in order to drop off the knife wands that were requested. The premises were setting up their barriers and had their knife arch configured ready for use and staff were arriving. The knife wands were handed to Jafric. The SIA Investigator spoke to Jafric and informed him that due to employing security directly he needed to have a SIA Licence, Jafric stated he was not aware and would apply in the next few days.

Club M were then visited by Bailiffs with the support of the Police to prevent a breach of the peace; this was around an outstanding debt. The Bailiffs were satisfied with the documentation they were shown and then left the Club.

During the evening of the 31/08/2018 Club M received multiple visits from the Local Neighbourhood Team and passing attention from the Response Team on duty. Staff reported feeling the atmosphere change in the early hours and described it as 'moody'.

On the evening of 31/08/2018 Club M received an enhanced Police Service with multiple visits and engagement. The premises have received support and assistance where possible to ensure the premises can operate safely. Despite this serious disorder has happened outside the location involving their customers, this has resulted in a fatality and serious injury to another male. It appears despite the best efforts of the management they continue to attract customers with a propensity towards violence and disorder.

Due to all of the above, the history of the premises and the continued serious crime and disorder, the West Midlands Police respectfully request that consideration be made for the committee to revoke the premises license. If the committee feel that this is not appropriate in the circumstances, the Police would like to offer an alternative of a reduction in hours of trade to 2am and the following conditions:

- (1) An ID scanner is to operate at the premises whenever the premise is trading for business.
- (2) Everybody will be subject to a search and will pass through a knife arch as part of this procedure.
- (3) Any external artists will be pre-ticketed events. There will be no facility to purchase a ticket on the door.

The West Midlands Police respectfully submit this application for your consideration.

I am Police Sergeant 6179 Sherrie Kimberley of West Midlands Police currently stationed at Coventry Central police station on ST Michaels neighbourhood. Part of my duties is to supervisor the weekend night time economy within the city centre of Coventry. On Friday 31st August 2018 I was on uniform duty in company with Pc 21159 BILLINGS, at around 23:00 hours we went to join colleague's from the Licensing team at Club M, Junction Street, Coventry in order to support them during a licensing check. On arrival at the venue I was surprised to see that the venue was busy with customers already as this is not normally the case bat this time. Following the licensing visit we left the building. A short time later I was made aware that bailiffs were outside the rear of club M and wanted some assistance with visiting Club M regarding the non-payment of business rates. I deployed Pc 8090 Turner and SC 79944 BENNETT into to the club with the Bailiffs. I remained outside with Pc BILLINGS, the atmosphere outside the club was fairly moody. There a number of glass bottles on the floor which I picked up and gave to one of the door staff. Engagement with the door staff was good at this time. It was clear from speaking with them that they were expecting a busy night as they had an planned event on Mr Eazi. Pc Turner came out of the club and informed me that he did not feel comfortable in there and that the atmosphere within the club was moody.

As the night went on we continued to conduct visits to the club and the surrounding area, the atmosphere was becoming more and more sinister. There was no positive engagement from people queuing in fact they appeared very anti police. At around 0300 hours I again visited the club, the atmosphere outside was awful, and I was very concerned that something terrible was going to happen, it was extremely moody. I was that concerned I relayed over my Police radio to the control room that the atmosphere was extremely worrying and I was worried that something bad was going too happened

On returning back to the station I updated my report with my concerns. On coming back on duty later that day I was not surprised to hear of the incident that happened when we went off duty.

I am PC 8090 TURNER of the West Midlands Police and I am currently attached to Coventry Central Police Station.

On Friday 31st August 2018 at about 23:55 hours I attended Club M on Junction Street in company with PS 6197 KIMBERLEY, SC 79944 BENNETT, PC 21190 BILLINGS and PC 7253 FARRELLY . We attended the location at the request of two baliffs. They had requested Police attendance as Club M owed buisness rent. We were invited in by a female I do not know but whom stated to the bayliffs was now in charge and showed them paper work to prove this. SC BENNETT, the two baliffs and myself entered the club and went to the first floor to check some paperwork, PS KIMBERLEY was engaging with the doorstaff at this time with PC BILLINGS.

I have done many walk through's of licensed premises over the past five years in my role as a neighbourhood officer who covers the night time economy, and have done walk throughs of public houses over my carrear. On this occasion it felt particularly moody as I walked through the club I found that patrons were standing in my way. It felt particularly unwelcoming and uncomforable to me as a Police Officer. I walked from the enterance to the stairwell inside and onto the first floor. Where the baliffs checked the paperwork and then we left the club. We were in the club for just over 5 minutes. We then left the club where I spoke with PS KIMBERLEY outside.

I found the doorstaff approachable, and their usual selves, happy to engage with us. But the patrons more anti. I was aware before entering the venue that the baliffs may close the club should they have the right conditions. I was extremely releived when the manager was able to provide the correct paperwork as I felt

should the baliffs decide to close the club with immiediate effect we would not have enough staff in the area to do safely. Inside the club was over 100 patrons with many outside in the queue. There was a private event later that night planned on the 1st floor as I saw reserved tables in the room.

I am one of the Neighbourhood Sergeants that has responsibility for policing St Michael's Ward of Coventry. I supervise a small team of Police Officers and PCSOs. The St Michael's Ward of Coventry is demanding and includes the City Centre, Hillfields, Spon End and Far Gosford Street areas of Coventry. I have been asked to give my views in statement form about Club M.

One of the premises that we often have to cover and patrol around is Club M. Club M is a nightclub on Hertford Place just outside of Coventry City Centre. It is difficult to get to as you can not access it directly from the ring road without having to clamber over barriers. You can see it from the main road but you have difficulty in getting to it. To attend the premises officers have to drive past it and around a long loop to get the cars to it. The road leading up to the premises is dimly lit and not overlooked by houses, flats or a passing road. Persons on foot outside the premises have a large number of ways to run off, escape, or hide things prior to our arrival at the location and can see us coming from distance

Myself and my team are used to dealing with volatile risky situations. So do not feel worried or scared about dealing with the majority of circumstances but Club M is a concern to the majority of them.

Over the months and years Club M has gained a reputation as having issues inside and outside of the premises. The main issues are with persons going into or exiting the premises causing problems and with people hanging around outside.

People hanging around outside are believed to carry knives and we went through a stage where large knives and other weapons were regularly hidden nearby including in the council grit bins at the back of Club M.

The Club itself is very dark inside and the music played very loud. This causes communications issues for when police officers have to go inside. I have been to a number of disorders inside and outside the premises and the atmosphere is often intimidating. I have been to police officer back up calls inside of the venue on more than one occasion where officers have needed urgent assistance. Officers feel uncomfortable going into the premises as they complete walk throughs as they feel their safety to be compromised.

My officers find patrolling Night Time Economy in this area very challenging as there are often groups hanging around believed to be committing anti-social behaviour, causing anxiety and concern to the general public. Persons do not attend the venue until very late often preloading before they attend. The officers are of the opinion that the club will let anyone in, there is no restrictions, and no dress code.

The persons hanging around outside often have their hoods up and identities hidden causing further angst

Incidents that we have in the City Centre with weapons, stabbing and assaults often appear to emanate from Club M. These incident also often appear to be drug related.

The fact that Club M opens until the early hours of the morning and there are often problems when the location is closing also makes it difficult to police as we often have far less officers available at 05.30hrs than we do at 02.30hrs.

This statement is the views of myself and other officers. If the matters needs reinforcing then there are other ways of looking at all the calls for service in the area that will back up the above claims.

I am the above named Police Constable for West Midlands Police, currently based at Coventry Central Police Station, Coventry, CV1 2JX.

I am currently working within the licensing department at Coventry Central Police Station. On Monday 3rd September 2018 I was made aware that an incident took place outside Club M, Hertford Place, Coventry at approximately 0525hrs on Sunday 2nd September 2018 where a male was fatally stabbed. Due to this, myself and PS 20458 Witts had cause to attend Harborne Police Station to view CCTV of the incident alongside the homicide team. I attended Harborne Police Station on Tuesday 4th September and viewed the footage available which showed a large disorder outside Club M on junction Street, which continued onto Hertford Place, at the time of the incident being on Hertford Place, the CCTV shows a large group of males chasing another male across the road behind a parked vehicle. A few moments later, it shows a male stagger away a few feet and collapse to the floor, the rest of the large group continue to chase the other male back onto Club Junction and then over the ring road, onto Croft Road and then onto Queen Victoria Road. At the point where the group get to Queen Victoria Road, they go off camera for a split second and then reappear outside City Arcade, at this point the single male being chased is attacked and beaten to the floor. The group continue to kick the male whilst he is on the floor until another male comes and stops the group from continuing. During this attack the male was also stabbed and as a result was hospitalised. The male that initially collapsed was found to have a single stab wound and was later pronounced deceased at the hospital.

I was then informed that the hard drives for Club M had been seized and were at Ridgepoint House waiting to be downloaded, I knew there were a number of cameras for Club M from previous encounters with the club so requested to attend Ridgepoint House to view some of the other footage.

Myself and PS Witts along with DC 29964 Ahmed then attended Ridgepoint House where we viewed some footage of the main entrance to Club M. It is at this point that I saw members from opposing sides in the disorder

leaving Club M at approximately 0500hrs having been customers of the club during the eve

I am the above named Police Constable for West Midlands Police, currently based at Coventry Central Police Station, Coventry, CV1 2JX.

I am currently working within the licensing department and on Tuesday 24th July I was asked to retrieve some CCTV footage from the DPS of Club M, Hertford Place, Coventry. At approximately 1200hrs on Tuesday 24th July, DPS Jafric KALINGA attended Coventry Central Police Station and handed myself a USB stick containing the CCTV footage of an incident which took place outside the main entrance to Club M at approximately 0450hrs on Sunday 22nd July 2018. This USB stick has been exhibited as reference (Exh Ref JK/01).

I then made a working copy of the CCTV and booked the master USB stick into detained property, property reference 2209609/C.

I have viewed the working copy of the CCTV which shows an altercation between a large group of males outside the club with a small group of lads who were inside the smoking area to Club M. There are two altercations, the first where the small group from inside Club M come outside to confront the large group outside, the security from Club M come out to diffuse the situation but the large group have removed belts and are using them as weapons. The small group from inside the club come outside holding champagne bottles. Security get the small group back inside the club but the large group remain outside and approximately 10 minutes later, the small group come back outside to confront the group again and at this point, the large group attack the small group with belts, bottles and one male removes a knife from his waist and stabs one of the males from inside the club in his stomach. The stabbing take place directly outside the main doors to Club M.

After watching the CCTV it is clear that the large group outside Club M are hanging around the vicinity throughout the night.

Once I had finished viewing the CCTV, I took the working copy to civilian investor Robert FARMER who edited the footage onto a DVD format.

I am the above named person and I am currently employed as a SIA Investigator, I have responsibility for a large geographical area which includes Coventry. On Friday 31st August 2018 I attended Coventry to complete some visits and checks at the Godiva Festival. I met with PC 7136 Healy and colleagues from Coventry City Council Licensing Team – Debbie Cahalin-Heath and Amanda Jones. We conducted visits at the Festival and then moved onto the City Centre.

At approximately 2300hrs we attended Club M, Hertford Place, Coventry in order for PC Healy to deliver some knife wands; whilst there I took the opportunity to interact with the oncoming door supervisors. I completed checks on five members of door staff who were all showing their SIA badges and were all appropriate for their roles. They informed me they were employed in house and paid directly by the Club; this means the management require a licence to manage and supervise security operatives. I spoke to the DPS Jafric Kalinga who stated he was not aware of this and did not have a licence. This is in breach of the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (S3). I took Jafric's details and informed him he needed to apply for his licence online and he confirmed he would complete this in the next few days. I advised him that a warning would be issued once his application had been received. To date this application has not been received.

I left the Club and moved on to complete further checks at other premises in the City.


