- To consider the following Motion, as set out in the requisition for an Extraordinary Meeting of the City Council, in accordance with paragraph 4.1.4 of the City Council's Constitution, signed by Councillors Mutton, Duggins, McNicholas, Mrs Bigham and Mrs Lucas

"This Council is concerned at the impact of the unilateral imposition of Single Status on service delivery to our constituents, as well as on staff morale including the provocative use of agency employees.

We believe that this has been caused by the unnecessary haste at which the Conservative administration sought to introduce Single Status on taking up office and associated intransigence, thus ignoring the benefits of a negotiated settlement. We therefore agree to go to assisted bargaining.

At the same time, this Council requests that the Chief Executive open up a dialogue with the Local Government Association and local Members of Parliament to establish if additional resources might be made available from Central Government".
