# 8.1 To be moved by Councillor Nellist and seconded by Councillor Windsor:

"This Council believes that the £20 billion earmarked for a Trident replacement, plus the annual running costs of £1.6 - £1.9 billion would be better spent on improved public services; and calls upon Coventry's 3 MP's to vote against replacing Trident when the matter comes before Parliament".
