Title
Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

1. Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 The report seeks to update Cabinet on the progress made on the statutory review of Polling Districts and Polling Places and seek approval for the revised polling scheme agreed by the Advisory Panel on Electoral Arrangements

2. Recommendations

The Cabinet is asked to:

- 2.1 Note the comments received during the consultation period required as part of the statutory review (Appendix C)
- 2.2 Recommend the Council to approve the revised polling scheme agreed by the Cabinet Member (Customer & Workforce Services) Advisory Panel on Electoral Arrangements (Appendix D).

3. Background

- 3.1 Coventry City Council is required to divide its area into polling districts for the purposes of parliamentary elections, and to designate polling places for each of those districts. In doing so, the Authority must seek to ensure that all electors have such reasonable facilities for voting as are practicable in the circumstances, and to have regard to the needs of electors who are disabled.

The following definitions have been supplied for information:

- A **polling district** is a geographical sub-division of an electoral area, i.e., a UK Parliamentary constituency, a European Parliamentary electoral region, a ward or an electoral division.
- A **polling place** is a geographical area in which a polling station is located. However, as there is no legal definition of what a polling place is, the geographical area could be defined as tightly as a particular building or as widely as the entire polling district.

- A **polling station** is the actual room where the process of voting takes place, and must be located within the polling place designated by the Authority for the particular polling district. The choice of location for a polling station is the responsibility of the Returning Officer.

In order to satisfy new requirements introduced into the Representation of the People Act 1983, the Council is required to complete a review of all polling districts and polling places by the end of 2007. That review began on 19th September 2007. A review then has to be undertaken every four years.

3.2 By conducting the review, local authorities must demonstrate that they have as far as practicable:

- a) ensured that all electors in the constituency have such reasonable facilities for voting as are practicable in the circumstances
- b) ensured that so far as is reasonable and practicable, the polling places they are responsible for are accessible to all electors, including those who are disabled, and when considering the designation of a polling place, must have regard to the accessibility needs of disabled persons.

3.3 Once a decision on the proposals is made the reason must be given for change or maintaining the status quo. The proposal must have addressed the reasonable requirements of electors in the area and accessibility for disabled persons to the proposed polling stations.

4. Review Process

STAGES 1 – 4 are complete.

4.2 As part of the consultation phase of the review, the Returning Officer is required to produce a submission on the review and any proposed changes. That submission includes a list of all polling stations used by the Authority and a list of those polling stations where problems have been identified with proposed remedies. These are attached:

- Appendix A – List of all polling stations used in 2007

- Appendix B – List of polling stations where problems have been identified and representations proposing changes or further review

- 4.3 In accordance with the review process a variety of interested parties were consulted at the beginning of October. They included councillors, Members of Parliament, ward forums, disability access groups and Age Concern.
- 4.4 The Advisory Panel met on 5 November to consider the Returning Officer's submission and to consider any issues arising from responses received during the consultation exercise and those raised by elected members during this period. These comments are attached as Appendix C to this report.

5. Recommended Polling Scheme

- 5.1 Following consideration of these submissions and comments the Advisory Panel on Electoral Arrangements requested that 35 polling places be further investigated by officers. These investigations have been carried out and a report back made to the Advisory Panel on 26 November 2007.
- 5.2 The proposed scheme is shown as Appendix D to this report. This proposed scheme shows 156 polling places serving 155 polling districts. This would result in 160 polling stations of which 19 are portacabins. However the Panel has also recommended changes to 8 polling places which have been highlighted. All Councillors have been consulted on these changes and no comments made. Where specific changes have been proposed to individual polling places ward councillors have been consulted. Their comments are reflected in Appendix D.
- 5.3 The cost of provision of polling stations for the 2007 elections was £25,221, of this the cost of provision of portacabins was £13,953
- 5.4 Portacabins are known to pose access difficulties for electors with mobility problems and especially those in wheel chairs. In the past temporary wheelchair ramps have been provided to assist access. Temporary ramps were also used at 26 other permanent buildings where access issues have been previously identified.
- 5.5 The Returning Officers submission in Appendix B lists all portacabins as having a potential need for improving disabled access. In addition it indicates 5 other polling places where further investigation was recommended to determine whether disabled access is/or can be made available. An assessment of these 5 sites has been undertaken.
- 5.6 Following a serious accident involving the use of one of these temporary ramps at a portacabin, a subsequent Health and Safety investigation has concluded that the ramps used currently are not 'Fit for Purpose' – they are required to be installed at the correct gradient, secured, handrails provided, have slip resistant surfaces, water run off features, etc, and the installation of such devices should ideally follow British Standard specifications. This will apply equally for permanent buildings as for portacabins. Following this review and investigation it is clear that the current ramps cannot be used in the ad hoc manner as was the case previously.
- 5.7 An alternative supplier of portacabins has been identified. They will supply 'event cabins' which are sited with an integral fixed ramp. The company has surveyed all current portacabin locations for size and suitability and there will be no need to change the locations where portacabins are sited. However, there is an indication of increased cost of some 25 – 30%. If this is the case then the cost of hire of portacabins would increase by some £4,200 based on the number used in 2007.

5.8 Temporary ramps have previously been used in 26 permanent buildings. These sites have been further investigated and some alternative arrangements been agreed. However, this still leaves 7 where there is no alternative disabled access within the site and where no alternative suitable building can be identified. Officers will continue to discuss this issue with the Health and Safety Team concerning suitable ramps. Each site will need to be assessed on an individual basis to identify if a suitable ramp can be provided. It is intended that this exercise will be started early in the new year following publication of the final polling arrangements approved by the Council, and completed prior to the publication of the Notice of Election in late March . Any suitable alternative arrangements for disabled access identified during these assessments are to be implemented for the 2008 elections where practicable.

6. Publication of approved Polling Scheme

The following documents will need to be published along with the final scheme at stage 7.

- Any correspondence/representations received in connection with the review;
- Minutes of any meeting considering revision to the proposed scheme;
- Details of the places where the results of the review have been published.

It is anticipated that there will be an increase in the cost of hire of portacabins by some £4.200. This is due to the requirement for portacabins to be sited with integral disabled access. This increased cost will be managed within the existing budget.

7.4 Health and Safety

The proposed polling station scheme takes into account Health and safety recommendations following investigations of an accident occurring at a portacabin at the May 2007 elections, involving the use of a temporary wheelchair ramp.

7.5 Legal Implications

The City Council is required to undertake this Review by virtue of the Electoral Administration Act 2006.

REVIEW OF POLLING PLACES AND POLLING DISTRICTS 2007: RETURNING OFFICER REPRESENTATIONS

This appendix provides a summary of those polling stations listed in Appendix A where problems have been identified that may need further investigation or improvement.

Portacabins – Problems identified

Detailed below is a list of portacabins used at all elections. Portacabins have been identified as having particular problems in terms of access for those electors with mobility problems and especially for those in wheelchairs. In order to resolve this issue the Council has identified an alternative supplier of portacabins. Each cabin will be sited with provision of an integral secured ramp. Currently a survey of current portacabin locations is being undertaken to assess size and suitability of the site for the new style portacabin. Once we have received the finding of this survey, we will consult further on any required changes to location to accommodate the new portacabin. This change of portacabin design will improve disabled access where they are used for the elections in 2008.
