<b>2.</b>	<b>QUESTION SUBMITTED BY: Councillor Windsor</b> <b>TO BE ANSWERED BY: Councillor Taylor</b>
<b>TEXT OF QUESTION:</b>  Given the lack of any real democratic consultation on the future of Hertford St post office by the mis-named "Peoples Post Office" would Cllr Taylor write to Post Office Limited asking them to delay the date of the end of the consultation to allow a properly organised town's meeting to be set up at a large venue. Each Coventry Citizen should be invited by household and Post Office Ltd should be asked to attend and a vote be taken on their plans after they have presented them.
