Can the Cabinet member explain why this has occurred and the continued failure to deal with the appalling road conditions along Woodway Lane.</p> <p>Can the Cabinet member confirm the nature of the contracts it has in place with specialists able to undertake road resurfacing work (as opposed to pothole repair).</p> <p>Finally can the Cabinet Member confirm that the Council has discarded the Highways Maintenance list that was supposed to identify priorities for road improvements against objective criteria so that now roads on the programme can now be dropped and others added on the choosing of the Cabinet Member."</p>
