

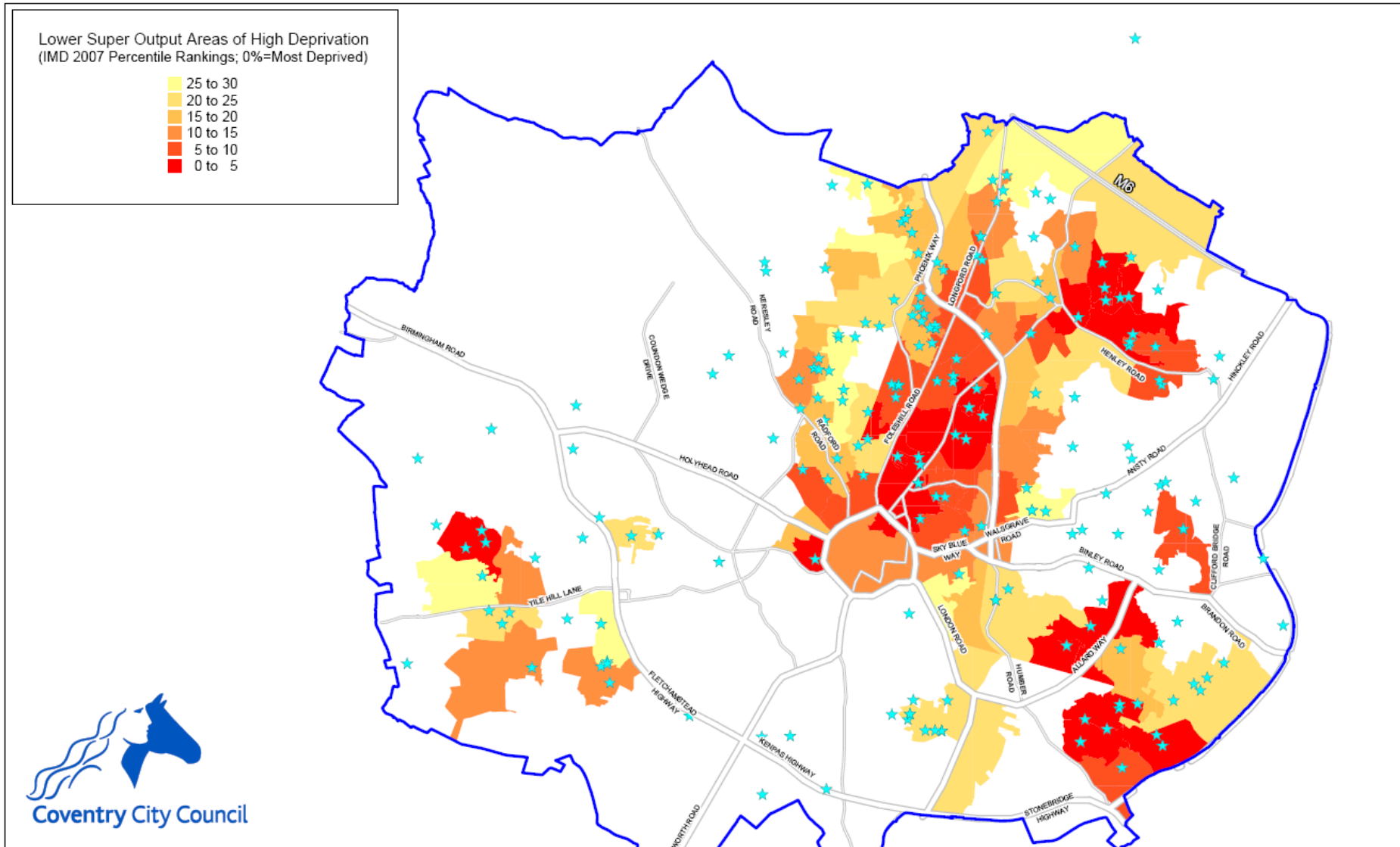

Headline stats for non-returned CAF's 2010'11

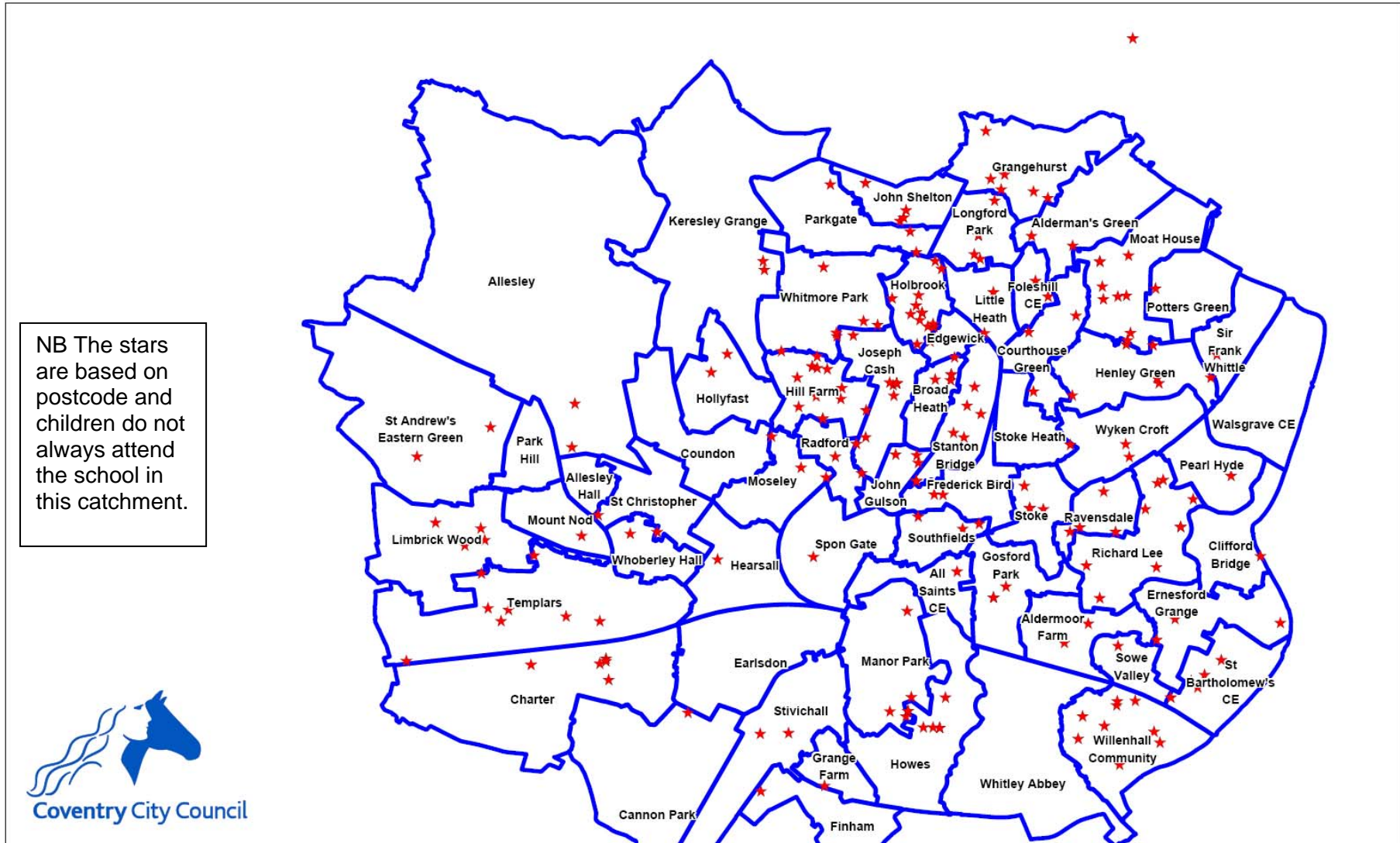
- Non>Returns for September 2011 = 201 (5.5% of cohort)
- Overall increase of non-returns by 14.
- Fall in forms from target schools (25) by 14
- 66 schools had one or more forms not come back (8 more than 09/10)
- 11 schools had 5 or more non-completed forms (3 less than 09/10) accounting for 44% of total.
- 34 schools had less non-returns than previous year (although 35 had more)

Postcodes and Areas of Deprivation



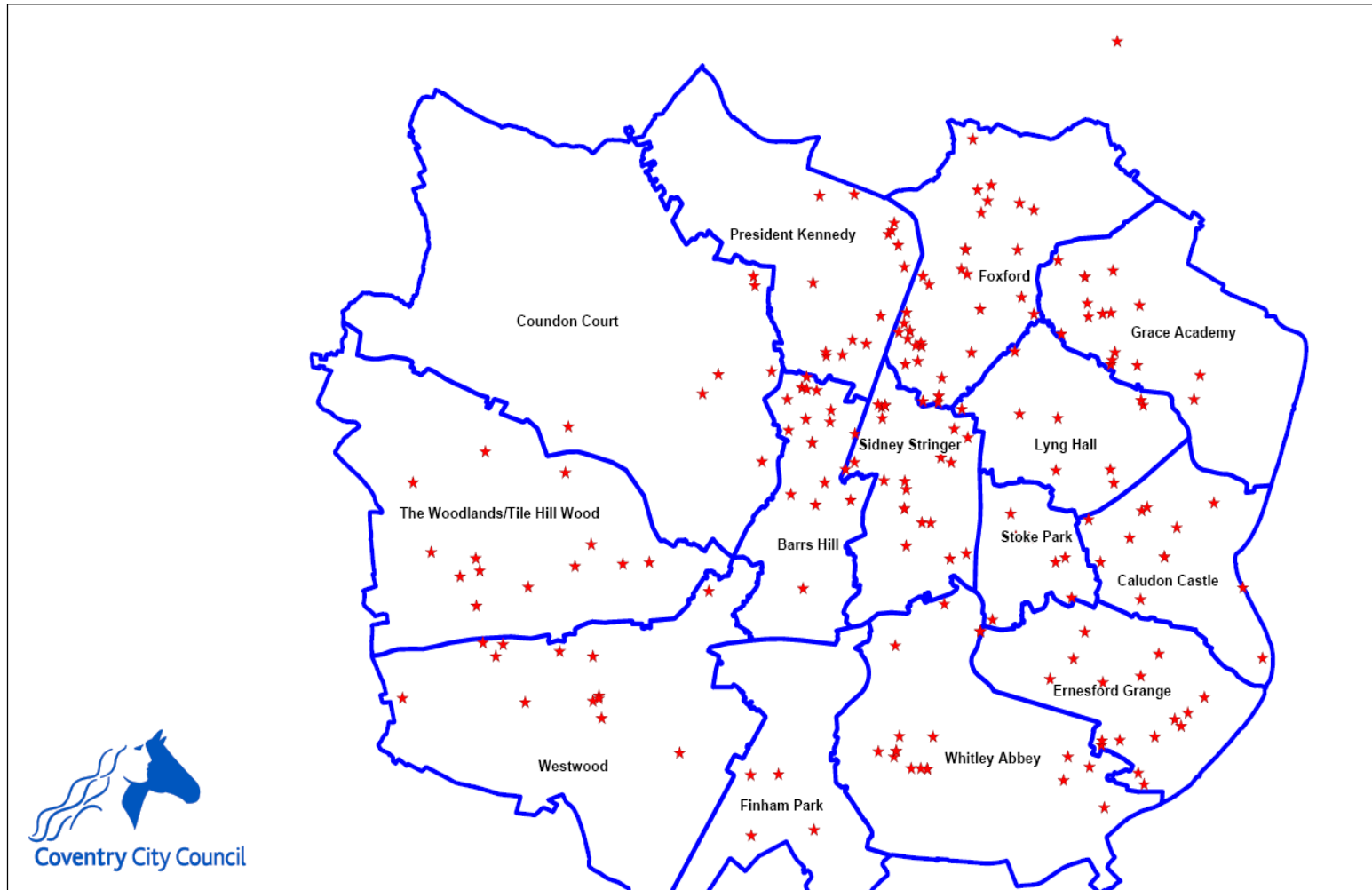
This shows where forms were not returned from for admission to Secondary school in 2011.

* 23 were from Catholic Voluntary Aided Primary schools and 3 from CofE Primary schools with no catchment areas (Leigh, St. John's and Stretton).

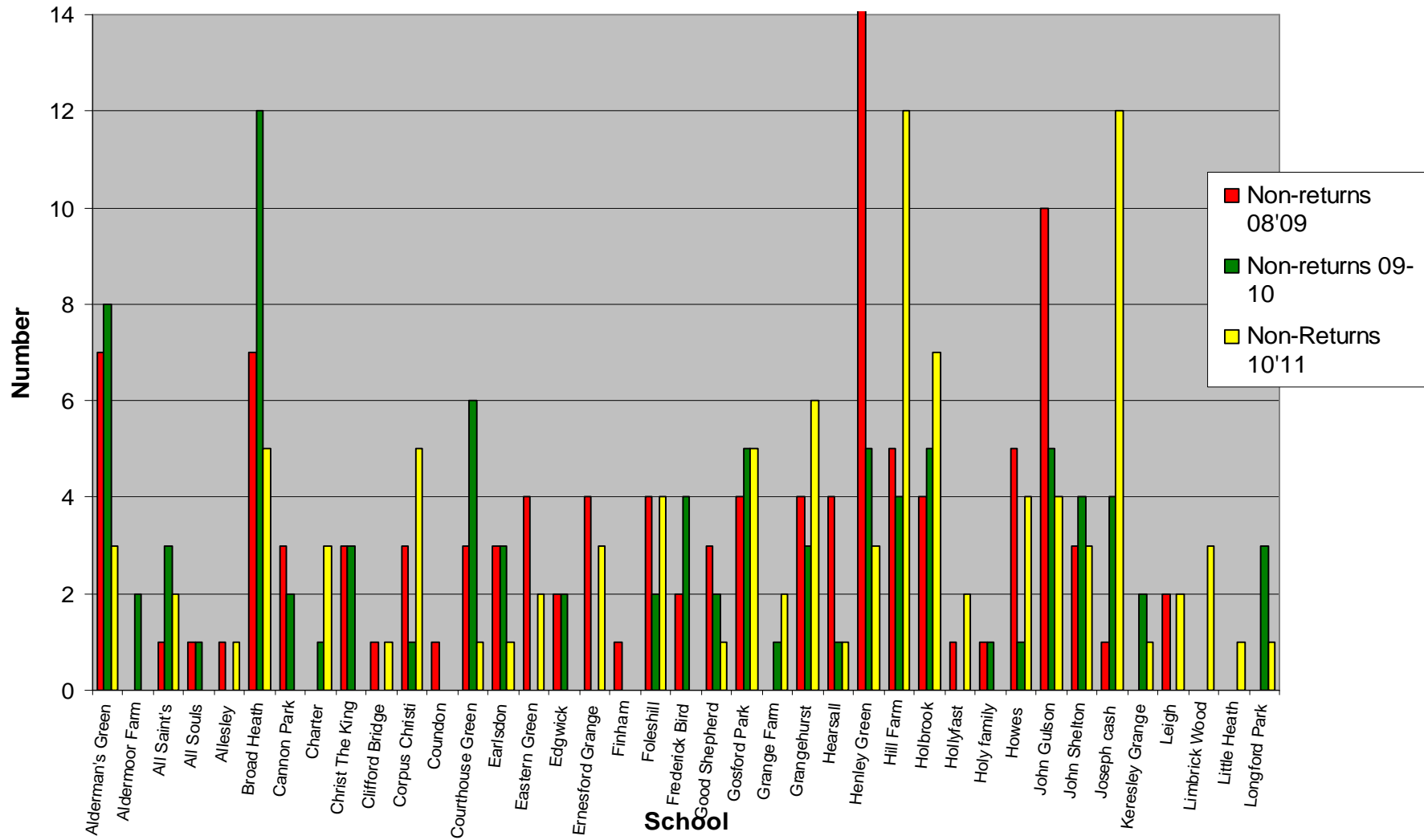
Postcodes and Secondary Catchments



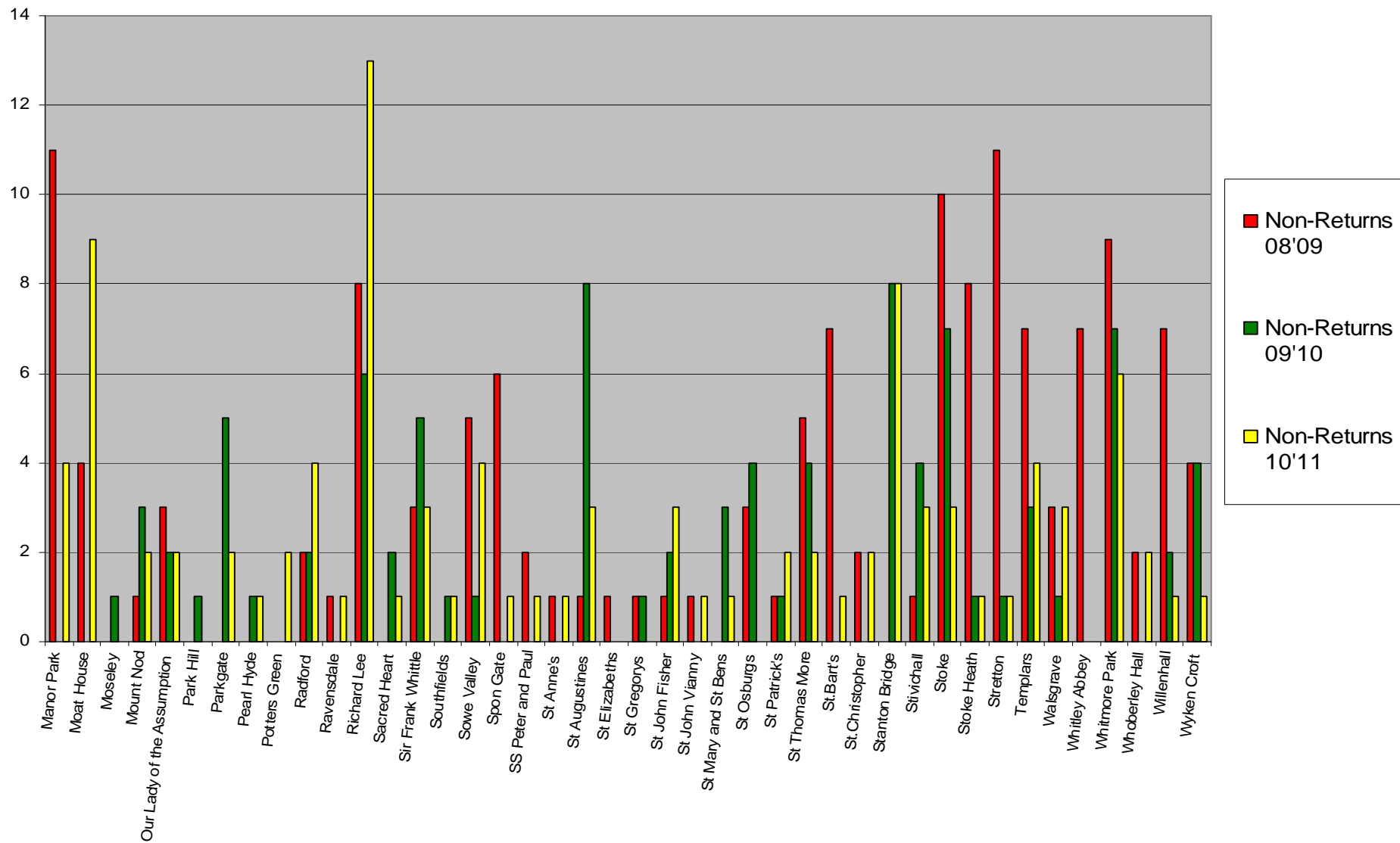
* There were 7 non-returns from feeder schools for Bishop Ullathorne, 3 for Cardinal Newman and 13 for Cardinal Wiseman.

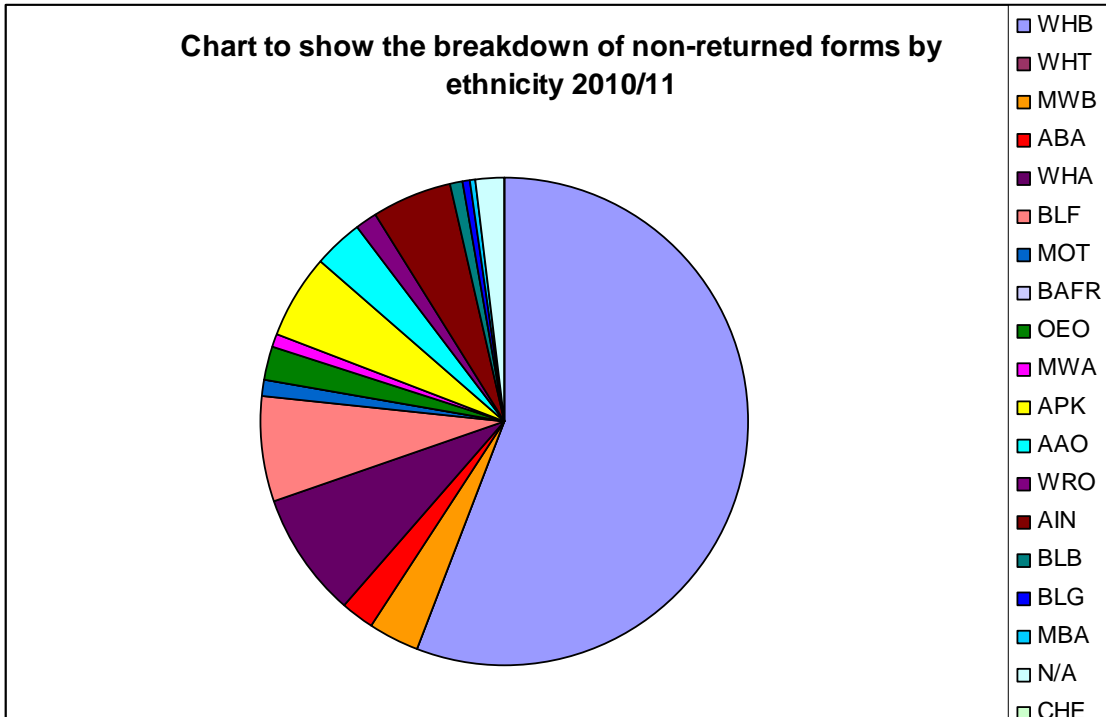
** 60 forms were not returned from catchment areas where schools are over-subscribed.

Primary School (A - L)**

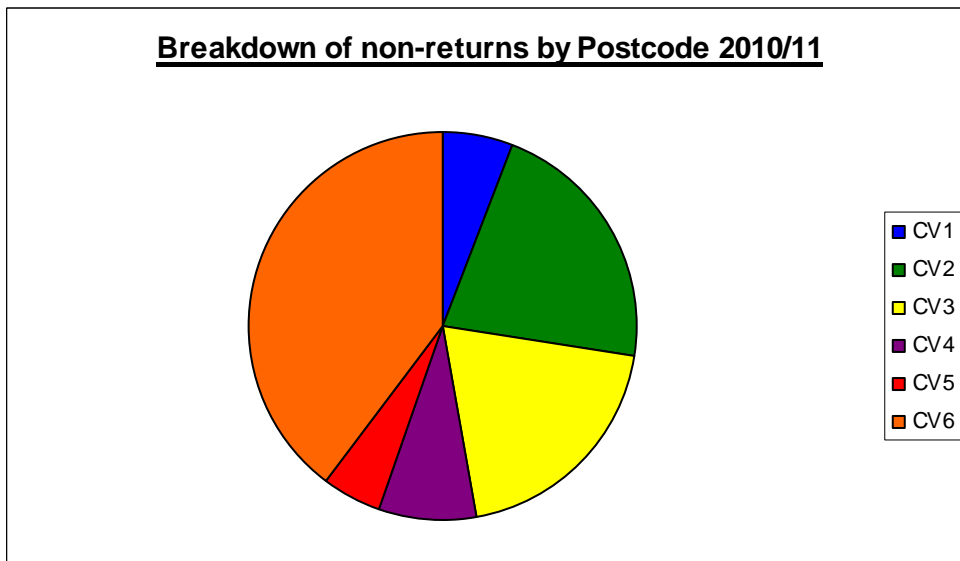


A graph to show the number of non>Returns of CAF's by Primary School (M-W)



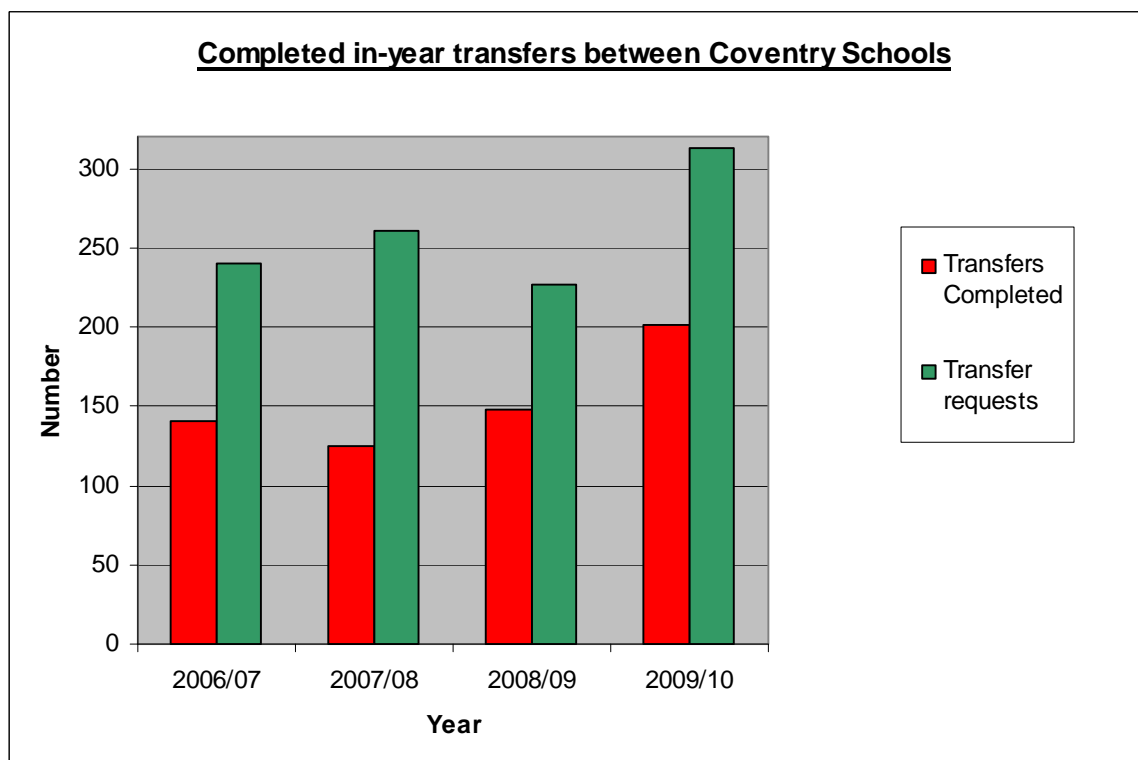
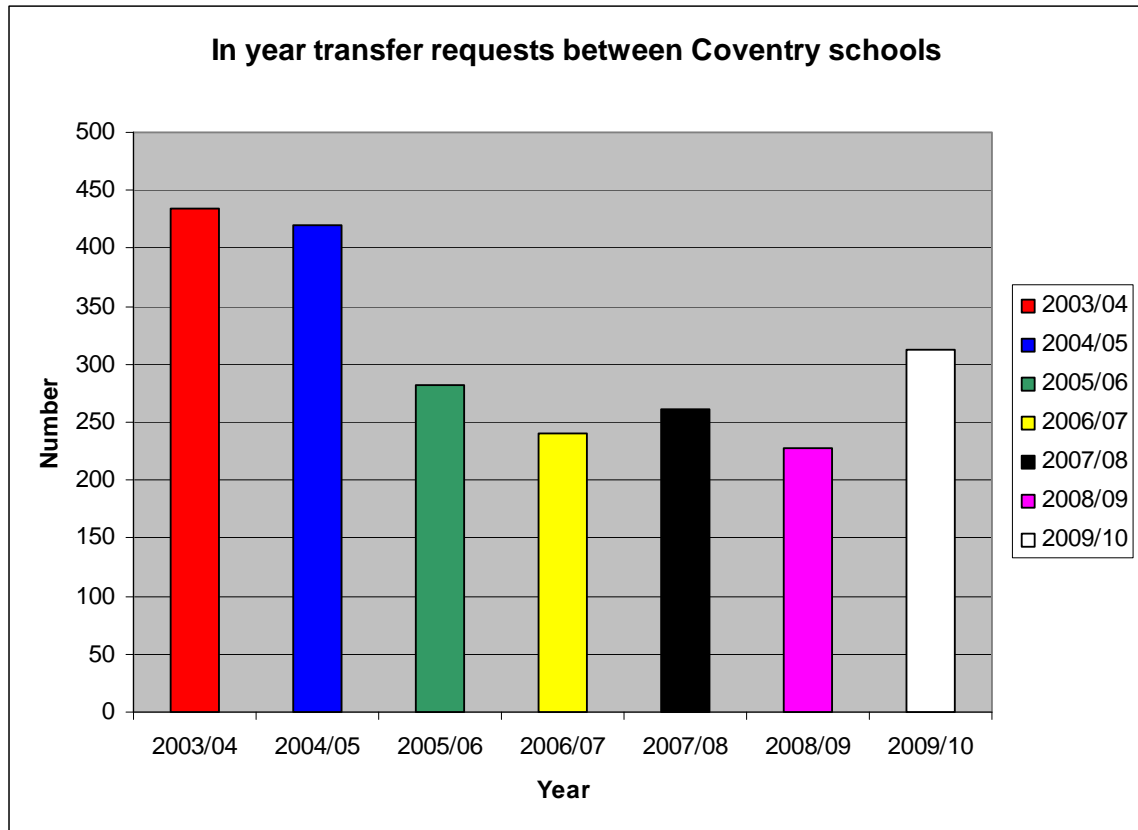


- Biggest increase in "Any other White background" (doubled), mainly Eastern European heritage children.



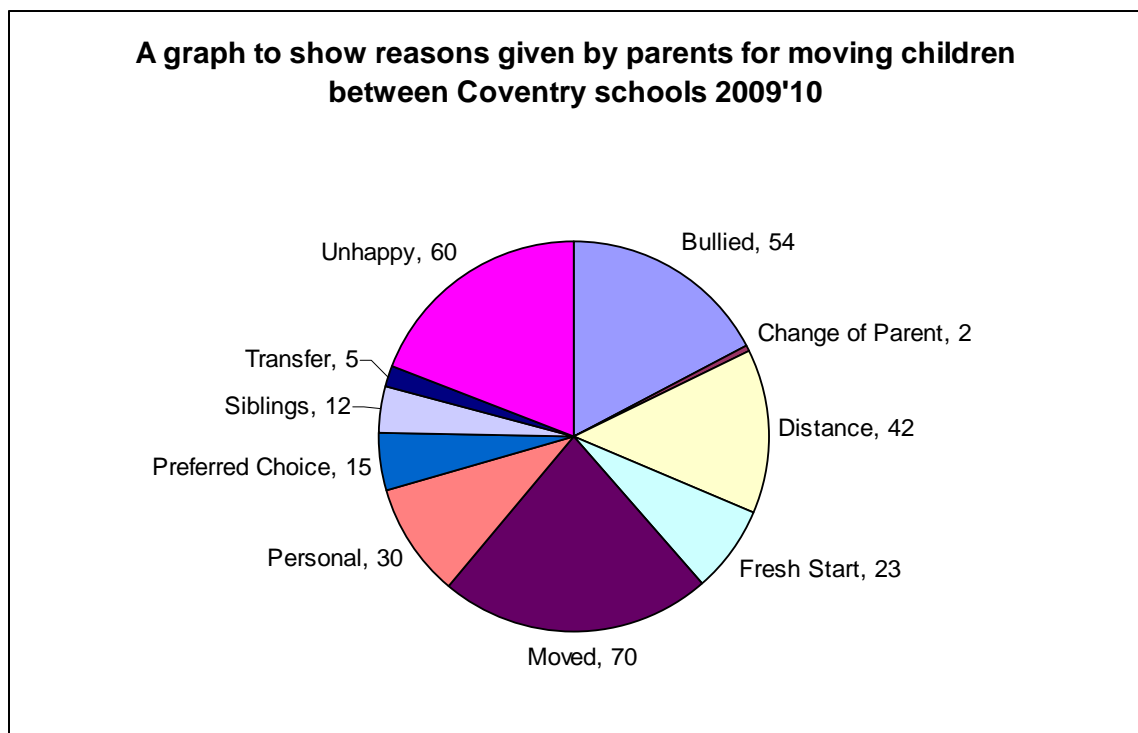
- Similar breakdown to last year, with CV6 having the largest number of non-returns (40%)
