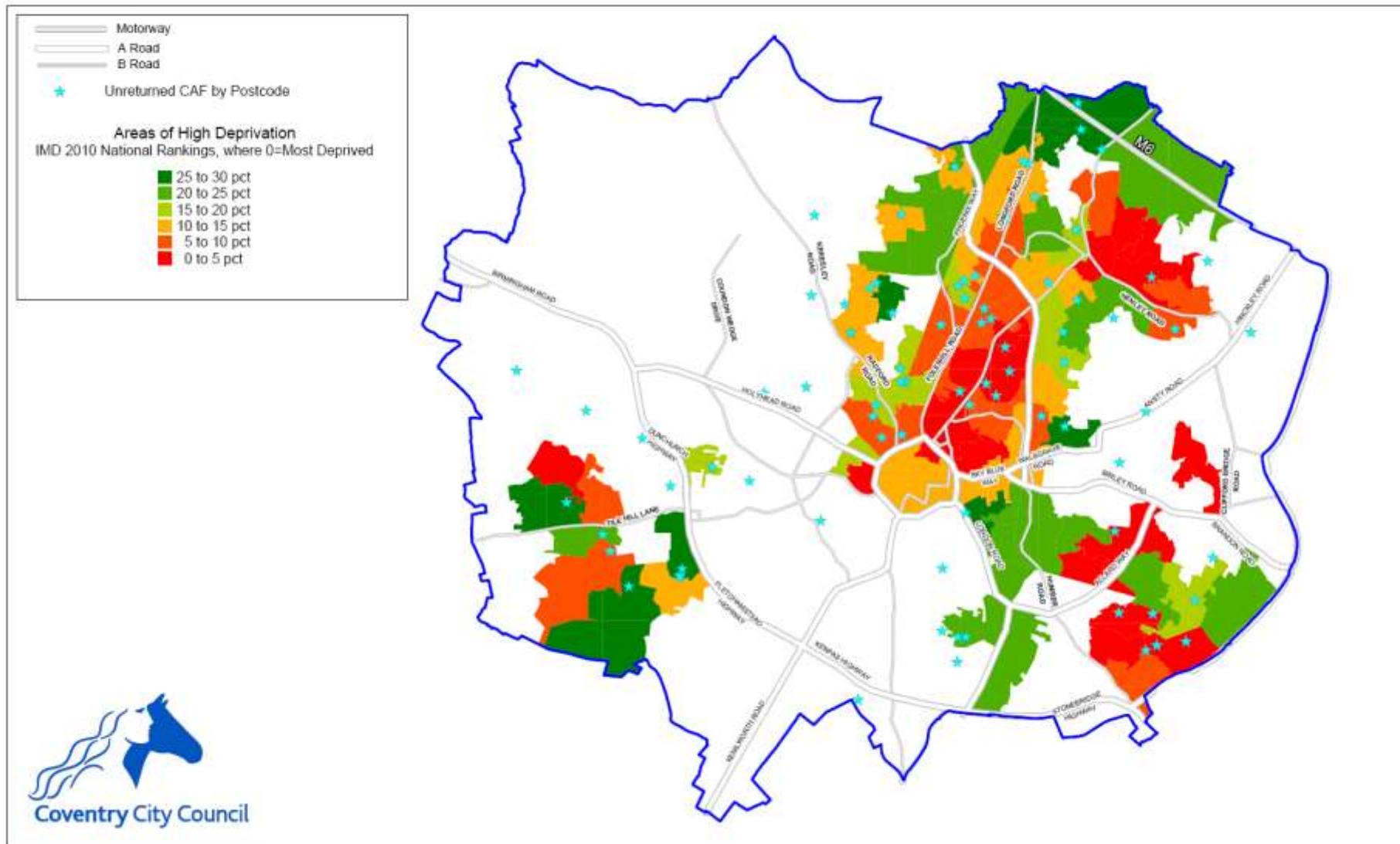

Headline stats for non-returned Secondary School CAF's 2011'12

Non>Returns for September 2012 = 89 (2% of cohort)

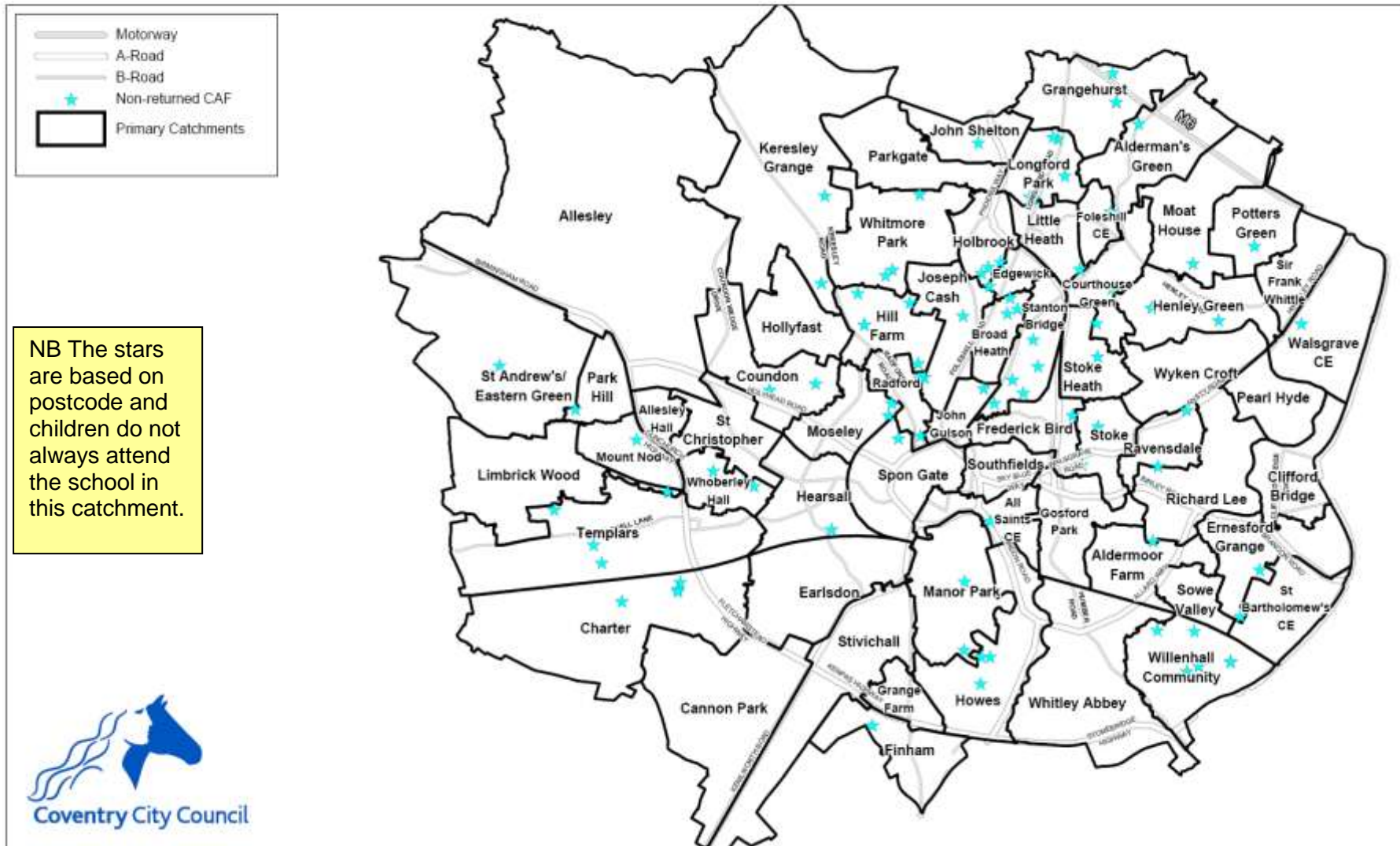
- Overall decrease of non-returns by 112 (56%)
- Fall in forms from target schools (27) by 74
- 44 schools had one or more forms not come back (22 less than 10/11)
- 5 schools had 5 or more non-completed forms (6 less than 10/11)
- 54 schools had less non-returns than previous year (although 10 had more)

Non-Returned CAFs and Areas of Deprivation



This shows where forms were not returned from for admission to Secondary school in 2012.

Non-Returned CAFs and Primary Catchment Areas



* 11 were from Catholic Voluntary Aided Primary schools and 1 from CofE Primary schools with no catchment areas (Leigh, St. John's and Stretton).

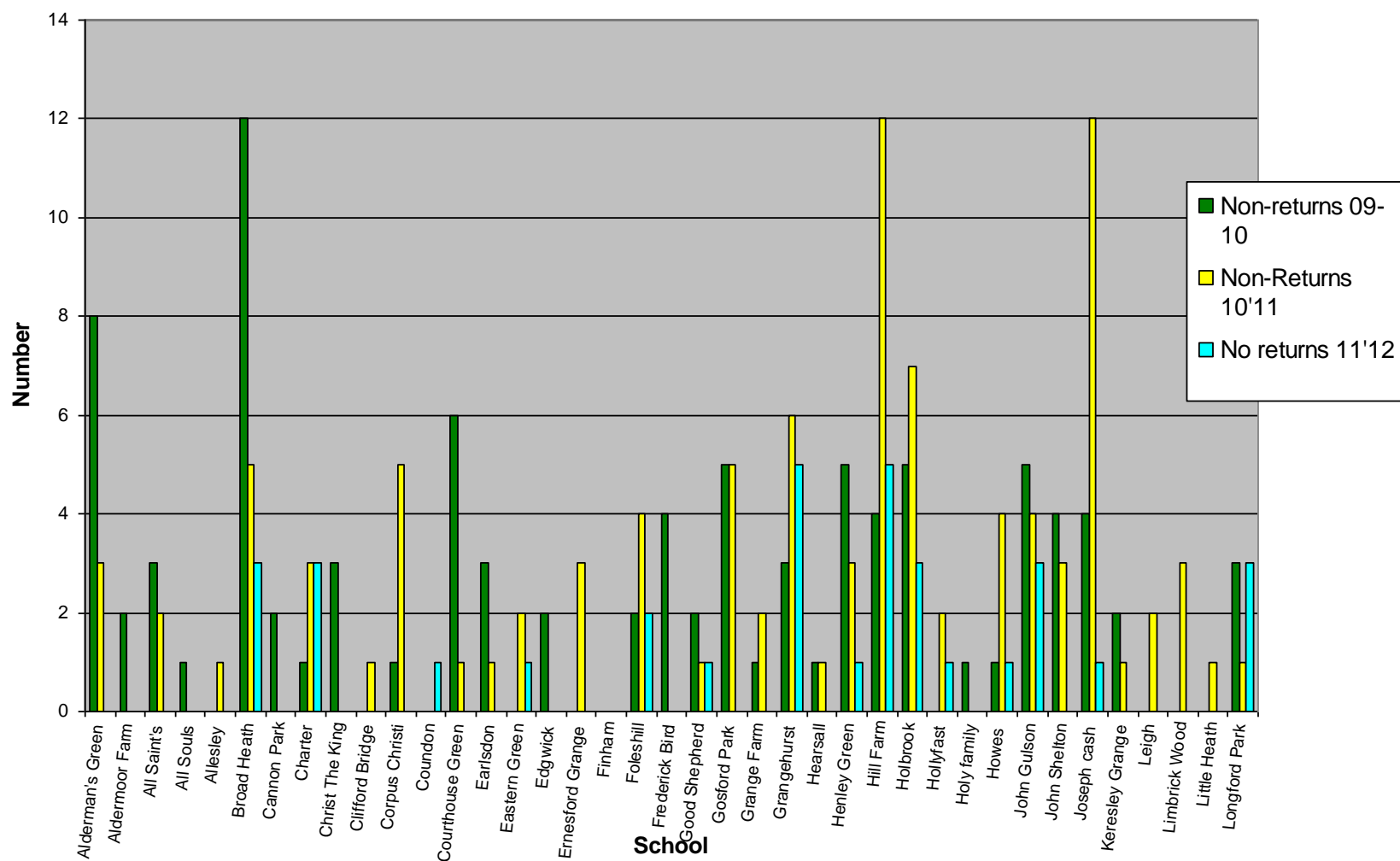
Non-Returned CAFs and Secondary Catchment Areas



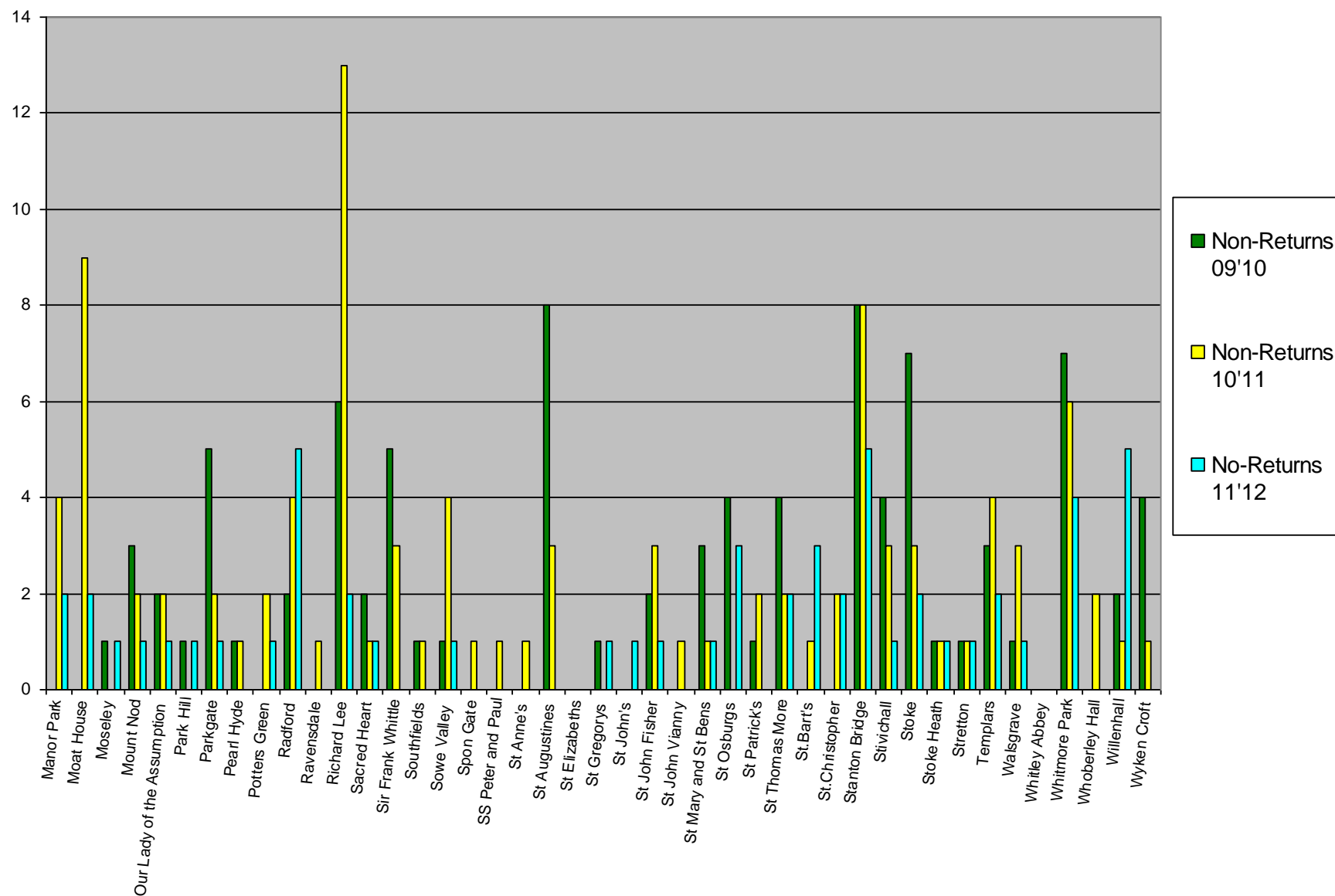
* There were 4 non-returns from feeder schools for Bishop Ullathorne, 3 for Cardinal Newman and 4 for Cardinal Wiseman.

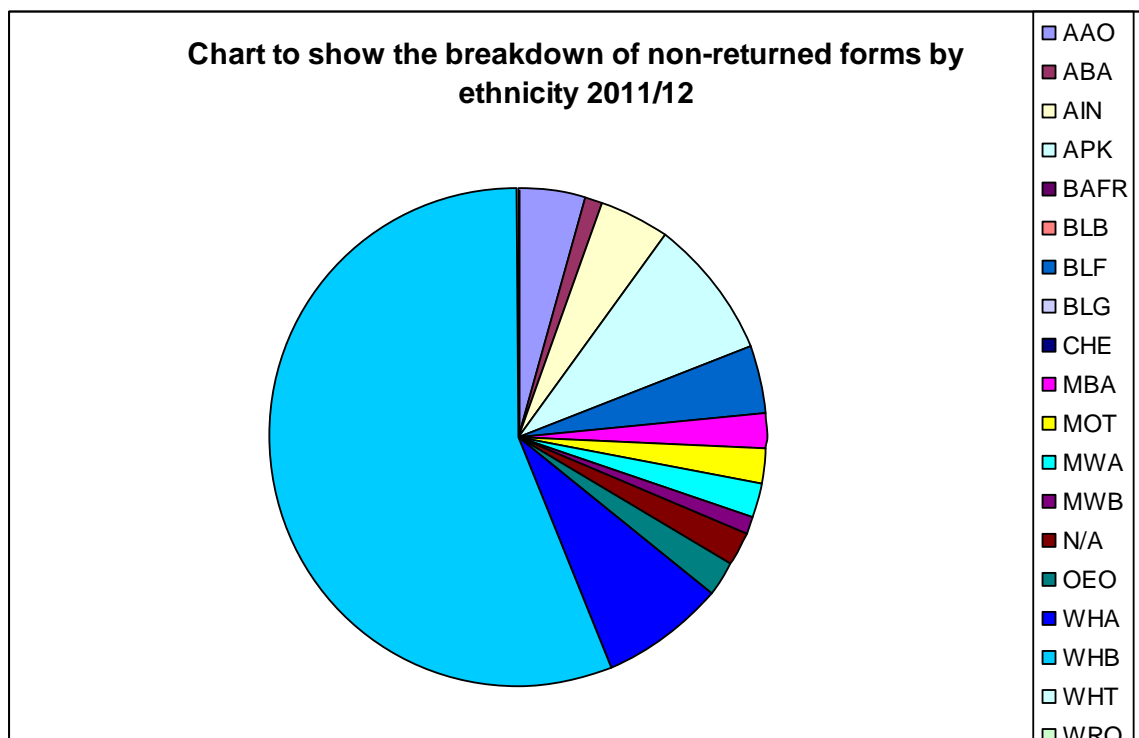
** 25 forms were not returned from catchment areas where schools are over-subscribed.

A graph to show the number of non-returns of CAF forms by Primary School (A - L)

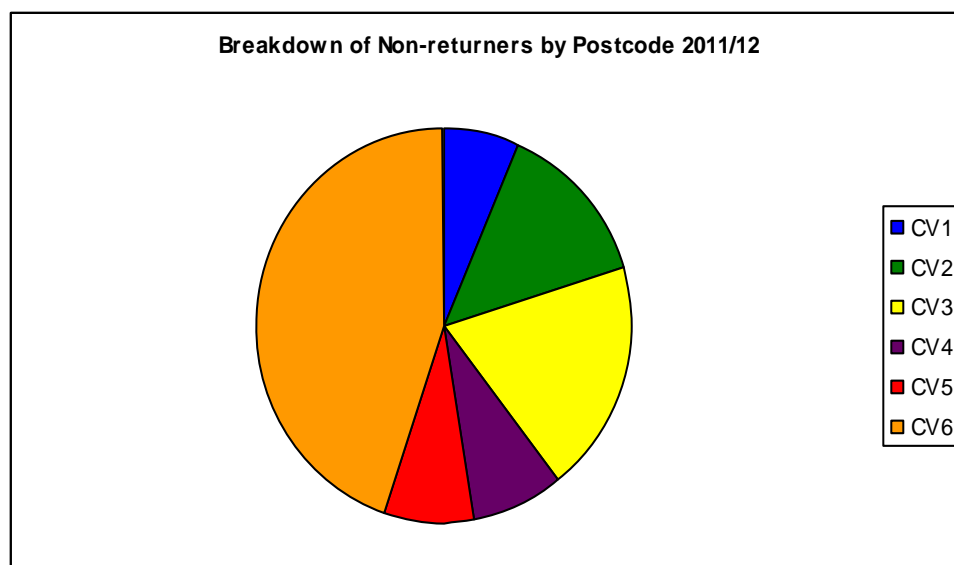


**A graph to show the number of non>Returns of CAF's by
Primary School (M-W)**



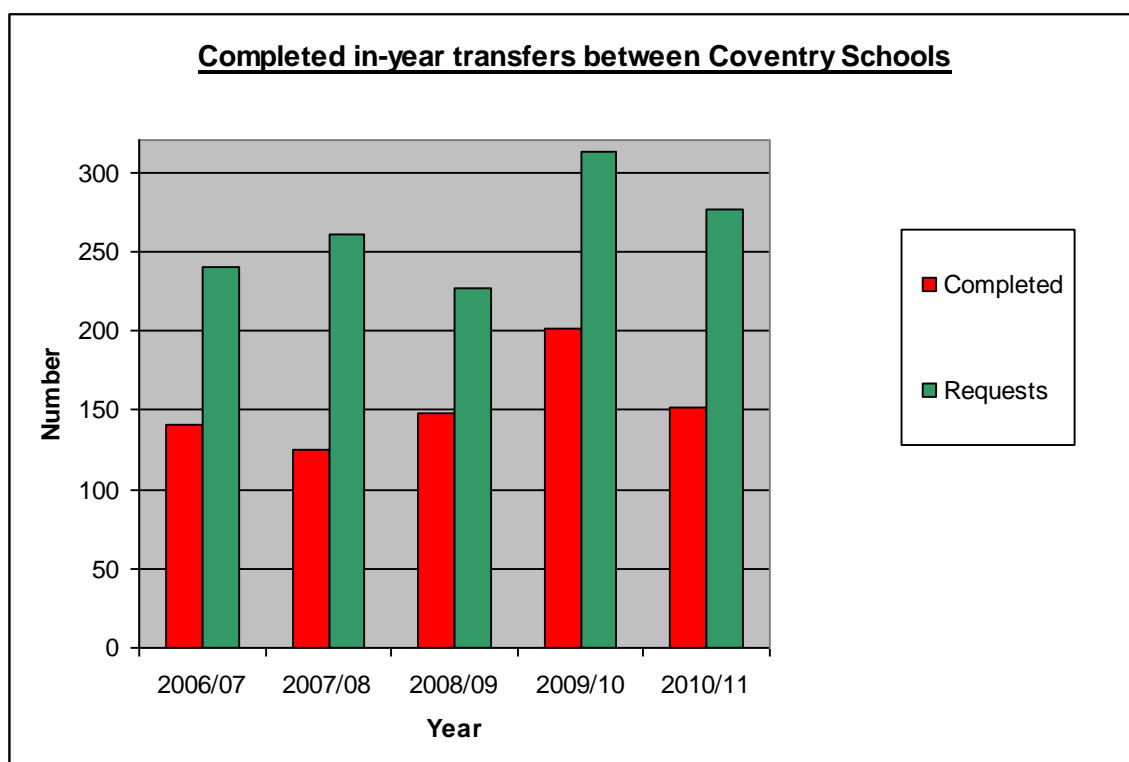
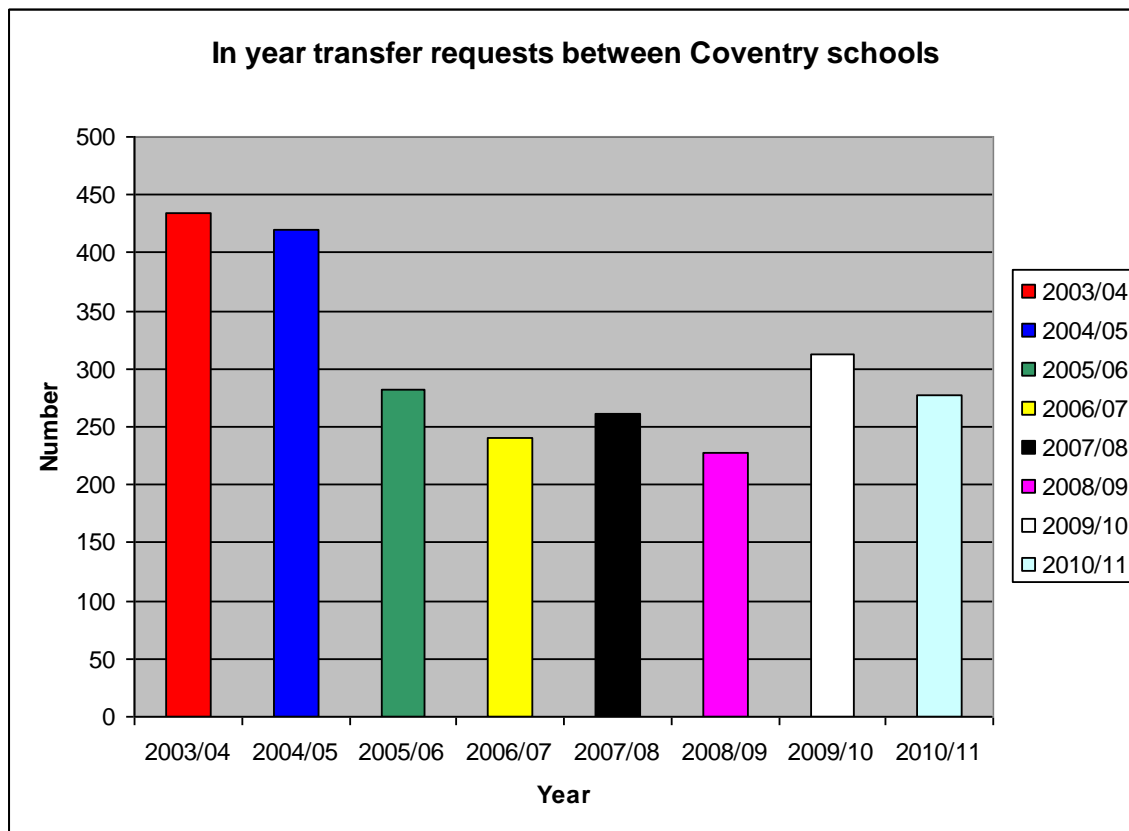


- No real trends/differences in ethnicity of non-returned forms, apart from reductions across the board. Black African (BLF) was the biggest reduction (↓75% from 10'11)



- Whilst the overall number was reduced across all postcode areas (↓72% in CV2!), CV6 remained the area with highest number of non-returns (45% of total)

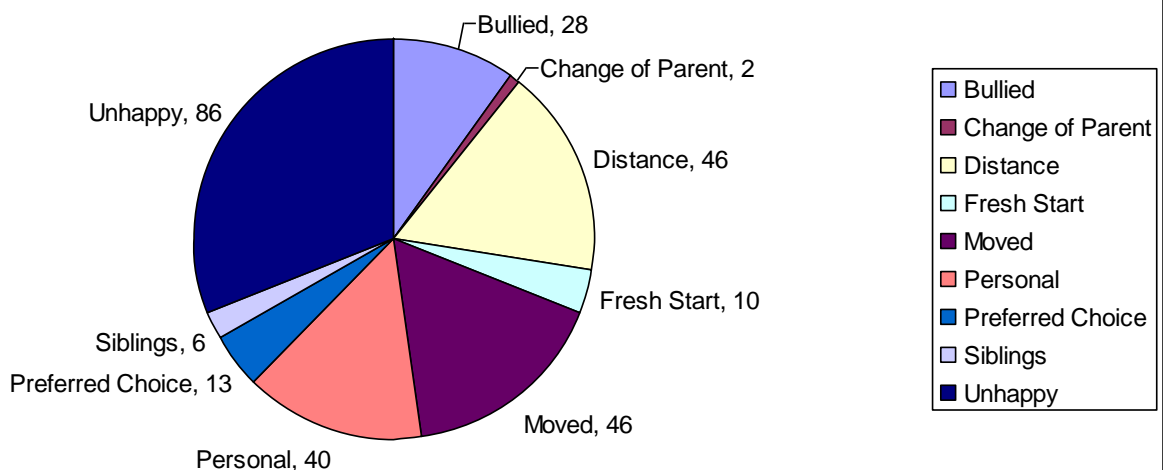
In Year Transfers 2010'11



Headline Stats for In year transfer requests

- Slight reduction (12%) in number of requests between City schools
- Percentage of transfers completed similar to previous year (55% compared to 51% in 10'11)
- Reasons given by parents for move similar to previous years
