- ✓ How do you ensure effective scrutiny and monitoring of completed reviews when the Chair of Scrutiny is from the controlling group of the Council?

- ✓ How do you address the failure of the Executive to either adopt recommendations or appropriately respond to the results of scrutiny?
- ✓ How do you effectively communicate to the public and media the results of a scrutiny review and the role of the Executive in responding to your recommendations?

In addition, you will have an opportunity to hear **Rodger Mann, Staffordshire County Council** and **Domenic de Bechi, Birmingham City Council** share best practice examples from their respective authorities.
