36. Call-Ins Stage 1

37. Medieval Precinct Wall to the Charterhouse

Further to Minute 141/04, the Committee received an update on progress with the Medieval Precinct Wall to the Charterhouse, which was on the English Heritage Buildings at Risk Register, with particular regard to the previous request that Officers investigate the feasibility of the City Council undertaking the required maintenance to the portion of the wall in the ownership of City College and take out a first charge against the sale of the City College Butts and Tile Hill sites. The Committee noted that a meeting was scheduled to take place on 14th July, 2005 with Bluecoat School to discuss repairs to the section of the wall in their ownership. The Committee requested an update at the next meeting of the Committee on the outcome of this meeting and deferred a decision on the section of the wall in the ownership of City College pending the outcome of the meeting with Bluecoat School.
