Report Back on the Work Of Outside Bodies - Daimler Green Recreational Trust 2010-2011

1 Purpose of the Report

1.1 This report sets out details of the work of Daimler Green Recreational Trust over the preceding twelve months and details of attendance by the City Council's representatives.

2 Recommendations

2.1 The Councils representative on the Daimler Green Recreational Trust (DGRT0 is Councillor Mal Mutton and recommends that the Council continue to appoint to this body.

3 Information on Work of Outside Body

- 3.1 The Community Centre continues to be well used by the local Community and provides a valuable venue for private functions .It is also used by other outside bodies such as various faith groups from within the City.
- 3.2 The addition of the licensed bar is proving to be a success in the fact that it not only raises much need income but it does serve as a focal point for sporting teams and the local community. There has been no discernable increase in anti-social behaviour because of the bar and any complaint is dealt with in a swift manner by the Centre Manager. The terms of the licence are being adhered to at all times.
- 3.3 It still remains a challenge to involve the local Community in any voluntary work at the Centre, but the Centre Manager is very pro-active in formulating ideas to encourage local participation in the running of the organisation.

4 Benefits to the City Council of the Appointment

- 4.1 The benefits to the City Council are that it is seen to be actively engaged with the local communities it serves
- 4.2 It is also beneficial that the Council are engaged with other agencies working within the local communities so that maximum benefits can be achieved by all parties for the benefit of those communities.

5 Attendance Record and Remuneration for the Appointment

- 5.1 The City Council's representative on the Daimler Green Recreational Trust is Councillor Mrs Mutton, who attended the Trustees Meetings on both the 16th January, 2010 and the 11th February, 2010. Councillor Mrs Mutton also attended the AGM and the Trustees Meeting held on the 11th November, 2010.
- 5.2 There is no remuneration associated with this appointment.
