## How will Universal Credit make work pay?

## Meet James >

 He is eligible to claim Universal Credit.James, aged 22, is a single person and becomes unemployed.


## Universal Credit payment = £508 per month

James moves into 12 hours of employment per week at the National Minimum Wage.

Take home pay
= £323 per month
Universal Credit payment
= £370 per month
Total = £693 per month James is $£ 185$ per month better off in work.

James increases his hours to $\mathbf{2 0}$ hours of employment per week at the National Minimum Wage.

Take home pay
= £538 per month
Universal Credit payment
= £230 per month
Total $=£ 768$ per month James is $£ 260$ per month better off in work.

With Universal Credit, James is better off the more hours he works, even if he works more than 16 hours a week.
