Subject: Universal Infant Free School Meals/ Pupil Premium Update

1 Purpose of the Note

To provide an update to the Education and Children's Services Scrutiny Board (2) on progress made with the local implementation of Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) and impact on the Pupil Premium.

2 Recommendations

You are recommended to note and comment on the progress made by Coventry schools in implementing UIFSM and issues arising regarding the Pupil Premium.

3 Information/Background

3.1 The 2014 Children and Families Act places a legal duty on state-funded schools in England, including academies and free schools, to offer a free school meal (FSM) to all pupils in reception, year 1 and year 2 from September 2014. The requirement does not apply to nursery schools and nursery classes.

3.2 The Council was allocated capital grant of £954,036, comprising £755,762 for LA maintained schools and £198,276 for Voluntary Aided (VA) schools. The VA element allowed for VAT but not the 10% Governors contribution. Academies were to be funded via the Academies Capital Maintenance Fund but only if an application was made. Capital funding was paid to local authorities in April 2014 and was subsequently allocated to all 82 eligible schools on a formulaic basis to assist in meeting the costs of for example, kitchen refurbishment, new catering equipment and utensils.

3.3 Schools were also allocated a flat rate of £2.30 per meal taken, based on actual take-up by newly eligible infant pupils, measured in the January 2014 Schools Census. Revenue funding was paid to local authorities at the end of June 2014 and covered the period to the end of the 2014/15 financial year. Allocation was initially based upon an assumed 87% uptake (based on the pilot schemes). An adjustment was made in April 2015 based upon actual uptake in the summer term 2015 to reflect whether a school was either above or below 87%.

4. Implementation

4.1 All 82 Coventry primary schools were able to deliver the entitlement from 1st September 2014, although there were challenges for a small number of schools, particularly where major capital works were undertaken.

4.2 During 2014/15 the Schools Catering Service provided ongoing support to schools which included:

- sourcing equipment suppliers through a mini tender exercise to obtain best price for all schools for common purchases such as fridges, freezers, combination ovens, cutlery, plates and dishes. This information was given to all school regardless of the arrangements that they had for catering;
- helping with assessing plans for kitchen extensions;
- providing suggestions for alternatives to building works, for example Kitchen Pods;
- making suggestions for changes to menus;
- making suggestions for new systems for queuing; and
- reviewing quotations to ensure that they offer value for money.

4.3 The Schools Catering Service closed in July 2015 and therefore support is now provided either through the Solihull Catering Service or private catering advisers/providers.

4.4 The take-up of school lunches on Census Day in October 2014 for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 for whom Universal School Meals were provided was:

4.5 Across the 47 infant/primary schools contracted with the Coventry Schools Catering Service, the average % weekly take up of FSM over the period to July 2015 was approximately 78%. The minimum weekly take up was 60%; maximum 80%.

5. UIFSM and the Pupil Premium

5.1 The Pupil Premium is paid for several different groups of children:

- Pupils who have been eligible for free school meals at any census point over the previous six years (currently paid at £1,320 per primary pupil and £935 for secondary pupils);
- Pupil who are in care or have left care (currently paid at £1,900 per primary or secondary pupil);
- Pupils classified as a 'service child' or in receipt of a child pension from the Ministry of Defence (currently paid at £300 per pupil); and
- More recently an Early Years Premium has been introduced for disadvantaged three and four year olds receiving free pre-school education providing up to an additional £300 a year for each eligible child.

5.2 To a certain extent the introduction of UIFSM removed the incentive for parents who qualify financially for FSM to make an application. It was therefore important for schools to encourage their reception parents to apply for free school meals before as only those children who have applied and qualified for FSM will bring pupil premium payments into the school. In addition there may have been pupils in other KS1 year groups who have never previously qualified for FSM who become entitled to free school meals due to family circumstances but again will have no personal incentive to apply.

5.3 Table 1 (below) provides comparative FSM eligibility data for January 2014, October 2014 and January 2015.

5.4 In January 2014 (prior to the introduction of UIFSM a total of 2,838 Year R to 2 pupils were eligible for FSM; in January 2015 (following implementation in September 2014) the numbers had fallen to 2,538 a reduction of 300 or 10%. This is despite a 3% increase in the total YR to 2 numbers on roll. A very basic interpretation of this would be that 300 less pupils claiming FSM (presuming they would be entitled) would lead to a loss of £396,000 pupil premium payments to schools in 2015.

5.5 The most significant differences have occurred in Years R and 1 where between January 2014 and January 2015 eligibility has fallen by 4.5% and 2.4% respectively.

5.6 The position since October 2014 has nevertheless improved for Year R as shown in Table 1 and Appendix 1 to this report. Eligibility has increased from 638 to 784 pupils an increase of 146 or 23%. There were however reductions in eligibility for Year 1 and Year 2 pupils of 8% and 4.5% respectively.

5.7 By January 2015 sixty-seven schools had either maintained or increased the level of FSM within Year R. In considering Key Stage 1, 46 schools had maintained or increased eligibility. The largest increase in eligibility was 27% for Year R at Radford Primary School; largest decrease, 14% at Little Heath Primary School in Year 1.

6. Conclusions

6.1 Despite the relatively short timescale between allocation and implementation all Coventry schools were able to deliver the UIFSM entitlement in September 2014 and no further problems have been reported for September 2015.

6.2 Officers will continue to monitor uptake and specifically will continue to work closely with schools to ensure that parents/ carers apply for FSM, given that pupil premium payments are based upon only those children who have applied and qualified for FSM.

6.3 Since February 2015 the Admissions and Benefits Team have updated the standard FSM application form to include details of the need to apply for FSM in order to assist the funding of their school. Schools were encouraged to provide parents with this information and asked to apply if they receive one of the listed benefits. Best practice from other schools was shared widely, and this resulted in the uplift in Year R numbers qualifying at the January 2015 census.

6.4 A project has also been undertaken to examine ways of maximising future FSM applications and pupil premium funding. Council IT suppliers currently estimate that there are up to 14,697 children on the housing benefit/council tax support data base who should qualify for a FSM, compared with 9,939 children currently estimated to be registered. Therefore work is underway to amalgamate free school meal applications as an automatic part of the process for all new claimants for housing benefit and council tax support. Changes should be in place by the end of the calendar year so that all claimants will only have to make one benefit claim to the Council, and whether they take up the free meal or not the school will benefit from the pupil premium payment. 
