#### 1) Extension of hours – Fridays and Saturdays

The application seeks to continue to permit the current authorised hours endorsed in the standard timings on the premises licence other than to extend the terminal hour for licensable activities on Fridays and Saturdays until 01.00 the following mornings with the premises closing to the public 30 minutes thereafter.

#### 2) Deletion of Annexure 3 conditions

All of the conditions located in Annexure 3 are requested to be deleted on the basis that they merely recite the permitted standard timings for licensable activities and are therefore unnecessary.

The variation is not anticipated to adversely affect the four licensing objectives and the remaining conditions on the licence are assessed to be sufficient for the proposals. The operating schedule has been completed on that basis.
