WHAT IS THE FORWARD PLAN?

The Forward Plan is a list of the matters which are likely to be the subject of key decisions by Council's Cabinet in the next four months. A key decision is one which has significant financial implications (involving expenditure, income or savings in excess of £500,000) **or** which has a significant effect on communities living or working in two or more Council Wards.

The Forward Plan sets out:-

- A short description of each matter requiring a decision and the Cabinet portfolio most involved
- The date when, or the period within which, a decision will be made
- The identity of any groups or organisations who will be consulted before a decision is made and the way in which consultation will be undertaken
- The way in which anyone can make representations about any matter requiring a decision
- A list of the reports which will be considered before a decision is made

WHAT IS IN THE FORWARD PLAN?

- On page **4** you will find a list of members of the Cabinet showing the Portfolios for which Cabinet Members are responsible. The Council's senior officers are also shown. Representations on any decision can be made to the named contact officer at any time before the date of the decision.
