

PC MARSTON AND PC TURNER WERE CALLED TO ZONE TWO DUE TO THE CAMERA ROOM HIGHLIGHTING THAT TWO 1C 3 MALES WERE ACTING SUSPICIOUSLY IN PALMER LANE. A DISCUSSION STARTED TO WHICH ONE OF THE MALES WHO IS KNOWN AS DJ CLOUD NINE STATED THAT HE WAS PLAYING AT AN EVENT AT CLUB SO/CLUB M. HE STATED THAT HE WAS FROM LONDON AND SOME OF HIS BOYS HAD COME UP FROM THIS EVENT.

WITHIN THE BURGESS AREA IT WAS VERY BUSY WITH LONDON MALES WHO WERE ALL HEADING TO CLUB M.



PC MARSTON AND PC TURNER THEN ATTENDED CLUB M TO WHICH JOHN WAS PRESENT, WHILST TALKING OUTSIDE LARGE GROUPS OF IC3 MALES WERE ARRIVING. JOHN WAS ASKED ABOUT THE EVENT TO WHICH HE STATED THAT THERE WAS A 21ST BIRTHDAY PARTY BUT NO EXTERNAL DJ'S. I ASKED DETAILS OF THE PARTY TO WHICH JOHN STATED IT WAS A 21ST FOR A MALE KNOWN AS ND ABOUT 60 GUESTS WOULD BE ARRIVING.

AS THE GROUPS OF MALES ARRIVED PC MARSTON ASKED WHOS PARTY THEY WERE ARRIVING FOR TO WHICH THE PEOPLE IN THE GROUP HAD MIXED RESPONSIVES FROM ARTY TO PARTY. THE MALES WERE ASKED WHERE THEY CAME FROM TO WHICH THEY STATED THEY HAD COME FROM BIRMINGHAM. WITH THIS OVER HEARD JOHN STATED THAT HE WOULD NOT ALLOW THEM IN AND RAN TO THE FRONT ENTRANCE.

ABOUT 10 MINUTES LATER THE MALES RETURNED TO PC MARSTON AND PC TURNER AND STATED THE VENUE HAD SAID THAT THE POLICE HAVE STOPPED THE EVENT. THE GROUP WERE INFORMED ABOUT THE POLICE CONCERNS AND STATED THAT THE VENUE HAVE THE RIGHT TO STOP ANYONE FROM ENTERING THE VENUE, HOWEVER THE POLICE HAD NOT STOPPED THE EVENT.

DUE TO THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE THAT WERE GOING TO BE TURNED AWAY AND WHAT PC MARSTON AND PC TURNER HAD VIEWED IN THE BURGESS AREA IT WAS DECIDED TO PRE WARN OTHER VENUES

WITH THIS INSPECTOR TAMBLING AND SERGEANT EAVES WERE INFORMED AND A DISPERSAL NOTICE WAS AUTHORISED. PC TURNER INFORMED ALL VENUES VIA THE PUBWATCH SCHEME ABOUT THE CANCELLED EVENT AND ALL NPT STAFF WERE ASKED TO STAY ON DUTY TO HELP CLEAR THE MALES AND SHOW HIGH VISBILITY.

I am Police Constable based with the West Midlands Police, from 2006 till early 2016 I was one of the licensing officers for the area of Coventry. Within that time I would assist coordinating operation cocktail, which was a deployment of police officers and the passive drugs dog to educate people about the dangers of alcohol and illegal drugs and to reduce the alcohol and drug related violence within the City in the night time economy. This operation was based on intelligence and on every deployment Club M/Club SO, Hertford Place, City Centre, Coventry was visited. Sometimes due to the intelligence the premise was visited twice within a night.

Over a year's deployment the following was found upon visits:

30/1/15- Operation cocktail visited the location. From the previous operations the smoking area and the attaching room was always the most vulnerable space within that premise. However upon arrival there were no door supervisors in the area. Customers quickly exited the garden via the far door as there was no control or supervision in the garden area.

Results from the deployment into that one area was, a male found with a bag of white substance believed to be cocaine. This male was placed onto the drug referral scheme. Also a male was detected with 6 ecstasy pills in his pocket and arrested for possession with intent to supply.

Whilst there, the door procedure was observed, the results were poor with no customers being searched prior to entry. Both amounts of drugs were found in the pockets of the customers, indicating that the customers felt safe not to hide the drugs, but just have them in their pockets.

From this result, a meeting was arranged with the DPS Darren Raynor as the management in the venue was poor and the customers were controlling the smoking area and the room attached. This meeting was conducted on the 3/2/15. The premise was placed on an action plan to move things forward, especially concerning the control and layout of the ground floor. It was agreed via the owner David Gains and Darren Raynor that changes would be implemented as the management agreed that the garden area was a concern. The alterations were agreed via the Police and the owners and the venue was placed on the corvus staffing template to be supported each weekend by the Police.

18/4/15- Operation cocktail was deployed to the venue, to which there was an increase in door staff and the DPS was present, however they were all positioned by the front entrance with no observation on the garden area. From the smoking area there were 6 indications, however due to the amount of staff at the front entrance the deployment of officers to get inside was delayed, to which officers could see a lot of movement inside the garden area and customers going back into the attaching room. It was felt that the delay at the front entrance limited the results found inside, as the customers would have secreted the drugs and left the garden area.

15/05/15-Action plan signed off and there was information that a new member of staff would be supporting the venue called John Hall.

15/8/15 from 2000 hours till 0200 hours I was on mobile patrol with PC Christopher Turner in the night time economy in the Coventry area. At around 2200 hours PC Turner was called via the radio to zone two, which at the time covered the area known as the Burges and surrounding roads. The camera room via the radio had highlighted that two IC3 males were acting suspiciously in Palmer Lane, Coventry.

Upon arrival, the area was very busy with males loitering around Mac Donald's and the surrounding roads. The atmosphere was classed as moody with people hanging about. The crowd's non-verbal communication towards PC Turner and me was hostile and moody. One of the males when we arrived had hid and stepped back into Palmer Lane upon seeing the Police, which caught my attention. From this, we spoke to the two males in Palmer Lane, I spoke to a male who called himself DJ Cloud Nine. He stated he was purchasing some food before going to Club M to play as a DJ at a gig. Cloud Nine said he was from London and that some of 'his boys' from London were coming to the event. I asked Cloud Nine if the people hanging around the area were coming to the event, to which he confirmed that they were.

Whilst in that area, I spoke to Lee Miles from EMK who was supplying Club M with door staff at the time. He stated that he was withdrawing his staff from the venue due to not being paid; approximately £10,000 was outstanding and that the venue was cutting corners by not having enough door staff working, which caused the door staff safety concerns.

From all this information and the atmosphere is the area, PC Turner and I attended Club M, to which John Hall was at the front entrance talking to a large group of IC3 males. I asked John what event was on tonight, to which he stated that there was no event, but a 21st birthday party, with just the normal in house DJ's performing. I asked for confirmation via documentation about the party, to which John stated there was no documentation, but the male was known as Jerry who was 21 and about 60 guests were attending. I asked if John knew about a male called Cloud Nine that was supposedly playing at the event, not party and suggested that John observed the social media feed to prepare the venue for what was being advertised and what potential crowds were being attracted to the event.

As the groups of males started to arrive I asked what party they were arriving for, to which the people in the group had mixed responses from Jerry's party, to Gary's party. Some of the members from the group didn't respond as I believe they didn't know what they were attending. The males were asked where they have come from, to which they stated they were from Birmingham. With this John over heard the conversation we were having with the groups and started to become all anxious and informed the door staff that the groups were not allowed in.

About 10 minutes later the males returned to PC Turner and me and stated that the venue had said that the police had stopped the event. The group were informed about the concerns the Police had, however that the Police had not stopped the event and at this point John had not informed PC Turner and I that the event was cancelled. At this point we were on high visibility on the grass area near to Club M to monitor the crowd to feedback to Inspector Tambling, who was the manager for the night time economy on that night.

Due to the number of people being turned away PC Turner and I conducted a patrol of all the other venues to pre warn the staff that people might be a little annoyed due to the actions of Club M and these people could be approaching their venues.

Whilst patrolling along Spon Street, Coventry there was tension at the bottom of Spon Street with people being refused entry. This also was reflected in the Burgess and lower Spon Street. From this, static visibility had to be conducted and dispersal advice given to try and reduce the atmosphere amongst the customers.

With this information, Inspector Tambling and Sergeant Eaves authorised a dispersal notice and officers were asked to stay on to support this order. It was concerning that Club M had not pre warned all the venues via the Pub watch radio; however PC Turner made the call to inform all the venues.

21/8/15-Meeting was then held with PC Bowes, Darren Raynor, David Gains, EMK security and the local authority about the weekend and how their poor management had impacted on the night time economy, police resources and had endangered other venues. There were also concerns over the external fittings of the venue and the internal procedures.

5/9/15-Operation cocktail- Due to the recent intelligence from previous operations, intelligence about drug activity later in the evening, also that the venue knew that we only visited the venue once per operation and that this venue was on a police action plan, it was decided that this venue would be supported twice in the operation on the same night.

The first visit was before midnight for which the venue was low in numbers. However I moved to the garden area immediately. Inside the garden area there were 6 indications with the atmosphere very hostile. A female was extremely aggressive and intoxicated, to which the premise were highlighted about. From this Darren asked her to be removed with her friends and she was advised by the Police to get a taxi.

We then re visited at 0300 hours on the 6/9/15, to which again the same procedure was conducted. As soon as I entered, I saw a male rush to the fence and try and throw over what looked like a kinder egg. Immediately he was detained and the egg was recovered which had 3 wraps of white substance in it. Crime reference number 20/cv/162916/y/15 was created. Also 11 people were indicated and searched. Whilst there, the same female that was indicated earlier was back inside the venue, however had consumed more alcohol and was extremely abusive and was arrested for drunk and disorderly.

Also the activity outside the venue was extremely active with a vehicle search being conducted as well. It was advised to Darren that this kinder egg clearly had been in the male's pocket as he was quick to try and throw it away. Again it was stated that the management were poor and that the customers were controlling this outside area. I suggested the DPS moves around this area constantly so that people smoke and then go back into the rooms.

1/11/15- An ambo log had been received over the weekend, where a 17 year old female had received facial injuries and had been taken to hospital. I called the injured party who stated that she had been inside with three other friends and all had been purchasing and consuming alcohol. Inside they had seen a girl from school that was 15 years old. The injured party said that she had been to the venue a few times as she was never challenge on the front entrance.

12/12/15-Operation cocktail, visited quite early due to the plan of the operation. Again the garden area was hard to contain with people, but nothing of note.

19/12/15-Operation cocktail was conducted, however there was a delay getting into the garden area as people had grouped around the entrance to the garden. From my experience I believe they did this to delay the Police from entering. Results were 18 detections, but no referrals as I believe the drugs had been thrown or past back into the club.

5/2/16- Attended the location around midnight to walk around the location rather than the venue. A walk through was conducted inside however the location was empty due to the time of the visit.

Since then no other dates for operation cocktail have been conducted. From my overall experience the concerns with the venue are repeatedly poor management and supervision, with no direction to manage the ground floor and in particular the smoking area. From the results from the operation the later we visited the venue the more hostile and out of control the garden area became, with people feeling comfortable that they could store drugs in their pockets. From the drugs found these were not for personal use but to supply to the customers in the club, again highlighting that customers felt safe to deal inside the venue; in the brightest most open part of the venue. Whilst operation cocktail visited the venue the only room which was visited was the garden area due to the layout and containment of the venue.
