**Subject: Preventative Support – Adult Services**

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## **1 Purpose of the Note**

- 1.1 To inform Cabinet of the outcome of Scrutiny Co-ordination Committee consideration of the Preventative Support - Adult Services, public and private reports, at their meeting on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2017.

## **2 Recommendations**

- 2.1 Scrutiny Co-ordination Committee made no additional recommendations but asked that Cabinet note that they have requested a report back on the implementation of the new services to monitor progress.

## **3 Information/Background**

Following an introduction to the Preventative Support- Adult Services report, the Board asked a number of questions about the proposals within it. These included;

- Why the decision was taken to grant fund as opposed to commission and the flexibility of grant funding
- The process for publishing the for grant applications
- Whether transition from Childrens to Adult services had been considered
- How does the prevention grant here link with the work of the Sustainability and Transformation Plan and their work streams on prevention
- Process for monitoring and feedback on progress

It was agreed that Scrutiny Co-ordination Committee would take a follow up report to monitor progress following implementation of the new grants.

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
