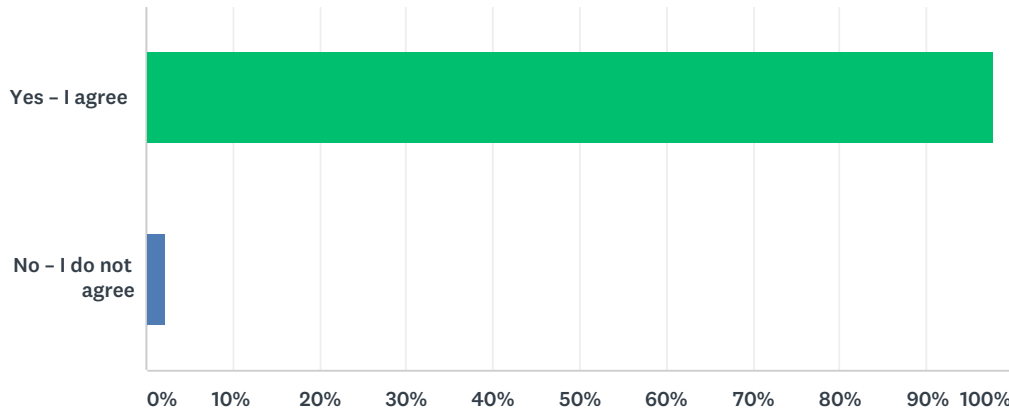


Q1 Do you agree that Coventry City Council officers should continue to deal with dog fouling where the owner fails to clear up after their dog?

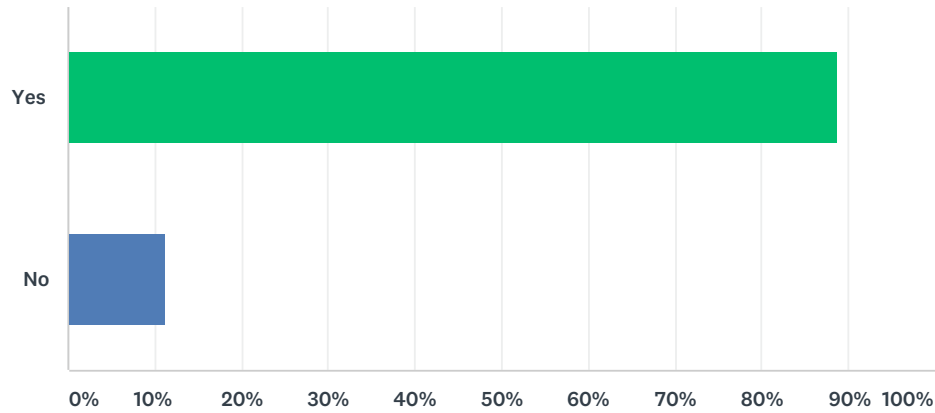

Q2 Do you believe that Coventry City Council should continue with a Dogs on Leads Order for specific areas of the city?

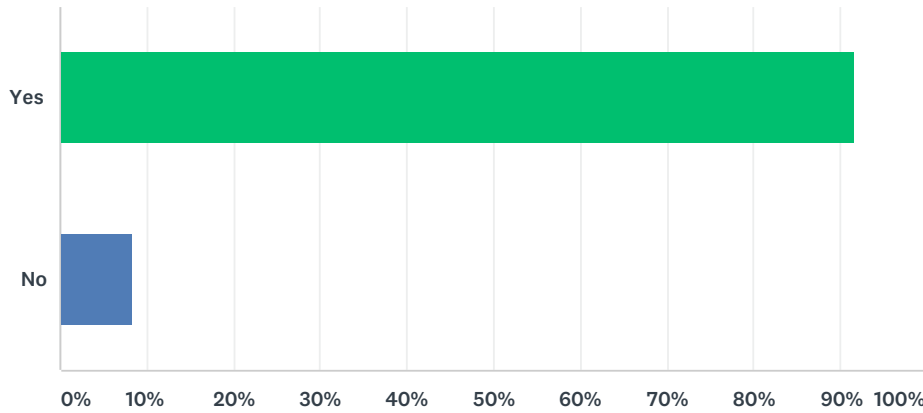

Q3 Do you support the inclusion of 'Fairy Village' at Allesley Park as a dogs on leads area?

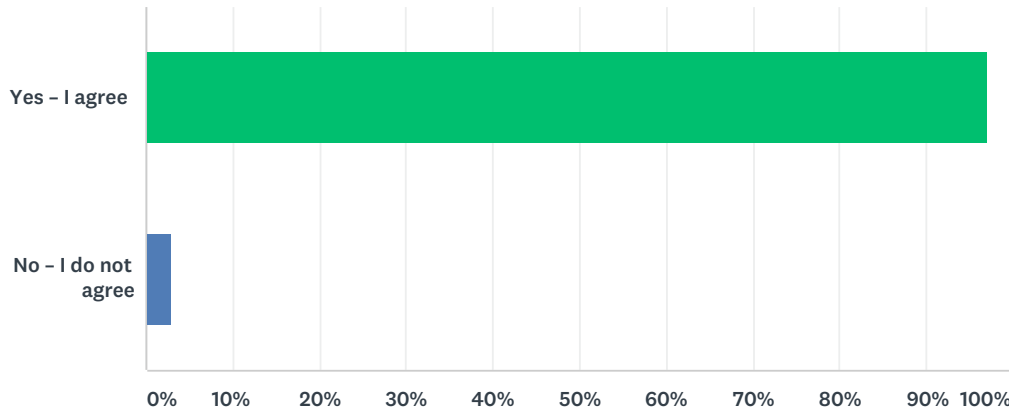

Q4 Do you agree that authorised Council officers should continue to be granted powers to insist that an owner puts their dog on a lead?

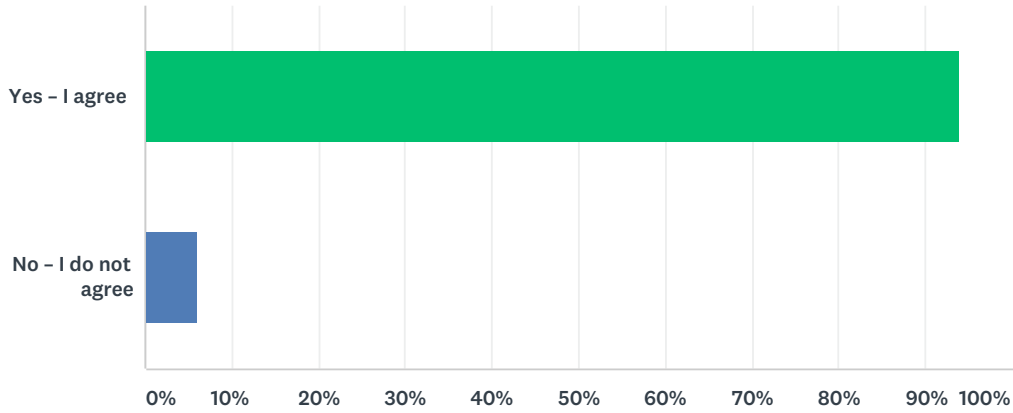

Q5 Do you agree that authorised Council officers should continue to be able to restrict owners from taking their dogs into certain places which are clearly signed?

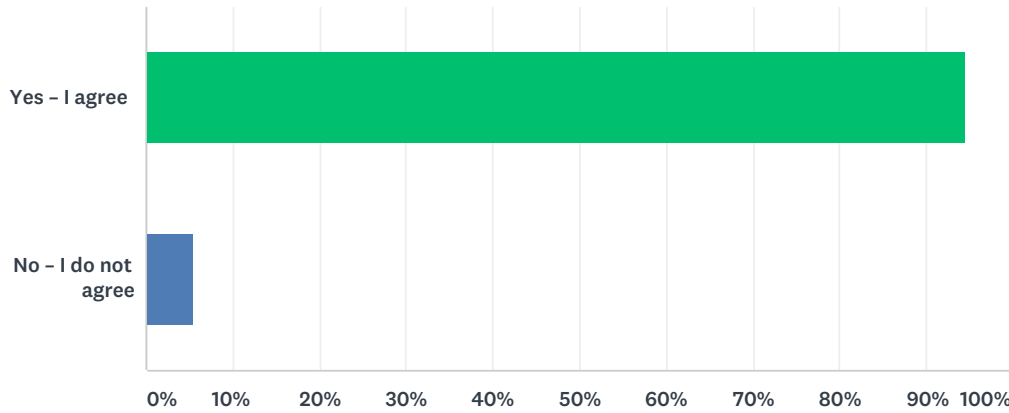
