As discussed If you can confirm the below conditions for the New Spires we have no objections to the application.

- 1. There shall be no use of the garden after midnight. Licensable activity in all external licensable areas to therefore cease at midnight.
- 2. The use of door staff will be risk assessed on an on-going basis by the Premises Licence Holder or Designated Premises Supervisor. When engaged, door staff shall be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
