Hi Michelle

As discussed If you can confirm the below conditions for the New Spires we have no objections to the application.

1. There shall be no use of the garden after midnight. Licensable activity in all external licensable areas to therefore cease at midnight.
2. The use of door staff will be risk assessed on an on-going basis by the Premises Licence Holder or Designated Premises Supervisor. When engaged, door staff shall be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
3. CCTV to operate at the premises to the agreed standards covering all internal areas. Images are to be retained for a minimum of 28 days and made available to download at the request of the Responsible Authorities.
4. Refusals to be monitored and documented.
5. All staff to be trained in basic licensing law. This is to be documented and refreshed annually.
6. Challenge 21 is to be operated at the premises.
