3 Background and Information

- 3.1 This year, as part of their annual summary of complaint statistics the Local Government and Social Care Ombudsman included the Chair of Scrutiny Coordination Committee, as an opportunity to "to encourage effective ownership and oversight of complaint outcomes, which offer such valuable opportunities to learn and improve". - 3.2 The letter and report are considered in detail by the Leader at his Cabinet Member meeting, a as well as Ethics Committee and Audit and Procurement Committee.
