## Exercise of emergency functions – Approval of spend of up to £500,000 to secure further Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- 1. Part 2M of the constitution of the City Council provides for the Scheme of Functions delegated to Employees including to the Chief Executive/Head of Paid Service.
- 2. Paragraph 3.8 of Part 2M of the Constitution enables the Chief Executive, in consultation with the Leader to make decisions required in an emergency.
- 3. As part of its response to COVID-19 frontline staff are continuing to work to deliver public services including caring for and visiting residents.
- 4. Some services have identified risk assessments that require them to use some PPE.
- 5. There is a national shortage of PPE available in light of the Covid 19 emergency and the City Council is working to secure provision of PPE for use as required by frontline staff.
- Funding to secure PPE up to £2million to be funded from the additional emergency allocation was agreed on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2020. Additional funding is now required to continue to secure PPE for use by frontline staff.
- 7. On the basis set out above I am satisfied that the decision being taken pursuant to this emergency provision is critical to the Council's ability to continue to support frontline services and I agree that £500,000 be available to source and procure PPE.

I have consulted with the Leader of the City Council to confirm his agreement to this course of action.

A report will be taken to Council at the next appropriate meeting that will include information about this emergency decision.
