#### **Executive Summary:**

At the Annual Meeting on 18 May, 2023, the City Council noted the allocation of seats to Political Groups in accordance with the political balance rules and made appointments to Council bodies accordingly.

Following the resignation of former Earlsdon Ward Councillor B Gittins, a by election was held on 26 October, 2023 at which Labour Party Councillor, Councillor Dr L Kelly was elected. The political balance of the Council therefore remains as it was in May 2023.

This report seeks to appoint to Labour party vacant seats on Council bodies in accordance with the political balance calculation.

### **Report title: Amendments to Appointments**

## 1. Context (or background)

- 1.1 Since the Annual Meeting on 18 May, 2023, when all of the appointments to Council bodies were made in accordance with the political balance rules, former Councillor B Gittins, a Labour Party Earlsdon Ward Councillor, resigned her seat.
- 1.2 On 26 October, 2023, a by election was held and Councillor Dr L Kelly was elected as an Earlsdon Ward Councillor for the Labour Party. The political balance of the Council therefore remains unchanged.
- 1.3 Appointments now need to be made to the Labour Party vacancies on Council bodies.
