## Petition – Update report regarding action taken to address incidents of anti social behaviour and damage associated with the Windmill Road entry way with access to and from Alderman's Green Road and Avocet Close

I ref er to the above petition which you submitted and write to inform you that the petition was considered by the Cabinet Member (Community Safety and Equalities) at his meeting held on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2011.

At that meeting, Councillor Townshend considered the issues contained in the report and matters raised at the meeting and the Cabinet Member approved the following:-

- (1) That the Longford Safer Neighbourhood Group continue to monitor, task and coordinate local measures and interventions to address incidents of offending behaviour.
- (2) That an adaptation to a lighting column in Windmill Road be made in order to accommodate the deployment of a domehawk camera to assist with the identification of perpetrators and evi dence collation to enable enforcement action where necessary and appropriate.
- (3) That the local Case Management Forum continues to identify, investigate and subsequently challenge the behaviour of any perpetrators identified as engaging in offending behaviour in order for necessary interventions to be applied an d facilitate behaviour change, including parenting, family and targeted youth support programmes.
- (4) That A frame motorcycle restrictive barriers be installed to the entrances of the entryway at Windmill Road and Avocet Close.
