I write to confirm that at this meeting Councillor Harvard t[ok ac&ount of t@ iss es t@t you rai•ed regardi} g the request for the reinstatement of the school cr[ssing patrol on Wi} sford Açenue by the entrænce to St. John's Primary School.

Councillor Harværd noted t@at the school crossing patrol siœ had be come vacant on 4 th January, 2011. In accordance with the us all practice, the opportunity had been taken to review the site location. Consideration had been given to the numbers of pedestri ans who crossed the sae and the two- way traffic flow over a t, elve hour period using the results from the most recent count undertaken on 25 th February, 2009. As uming that there had been no change since this time, then the school crossing patrol was numerically justified.

In light of the count details and the concerns rais ed by local residents, Councillor Harvard gave approval for the lo&ation to remain a school crossing patrol site and for the vacant post to be filled, subject to a suitable applicant being appointed. He not ed your comments expressing support for this decision.
