## Report Back on Petition – Request for a Pe destrian Crossing on Kenilworth Road Near The Firs

I refer to the above petition submitted by Councillor Taylor which you supported and was the subject of a further report at the Cabinet Member (City Services) meeting on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2011. Foll owing the end of the call-in period, I write to confirm that at this meeting Councillor Harvard took account of the comments you made regarding the request for a pedestrian crossing on Kenilworth Road near The Firs.

Councillor Harvard noted the results of the traffic flows and pedestrian crossing counts that had been undertaken which indicated that only a small number of adults and accompanied children crossed the Kenilworth Road near The Firs. He also noted that the traffic speed results demonstrated that there was a good compliance with the 40mph speed limit.

In view of these results and the options for pedestrians to use either the pedestrian crossing facility at the Warwick Road/Kenilworth Road junction or the refuge island facility at Earlsdon Avenue South/Kenilworth Road, Councillor Harvard decided that no further action should be taken in respect of the request for a pedestrian crossing on Kenilworth Road near The Firs.

Councillor Harvard gave approval that when the junction at Kenilworth Road/Earlsdon Avenue Sout h is refurbished, pedestrian facili ties are included. Funding for these works would need to be sought from a future year's capital programme. The ant icipated costs of such works is usually between £100,000 and £120,000 and Councillor Harvard decided that it was not appropriate to seek such funds at the current time.



No doubt you will inform the petitioners accordingly. I am sending a copy of this letter to the petition spokesperson Alex Agranovsky and also to the other Earlsdon Ward Councillors for their information.
