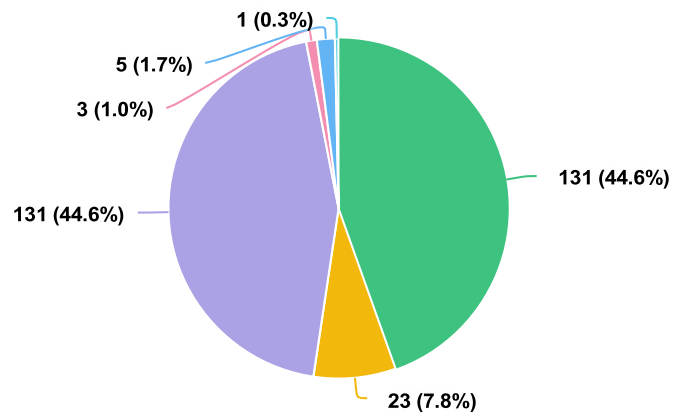

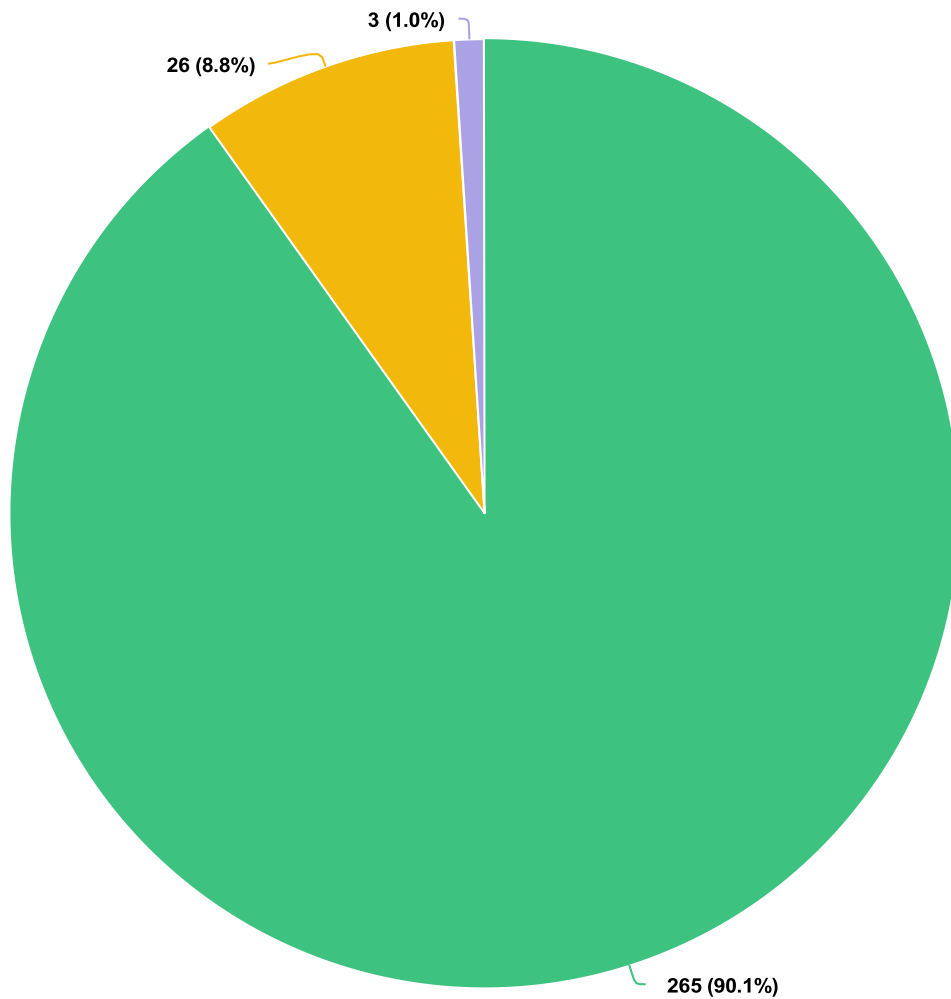

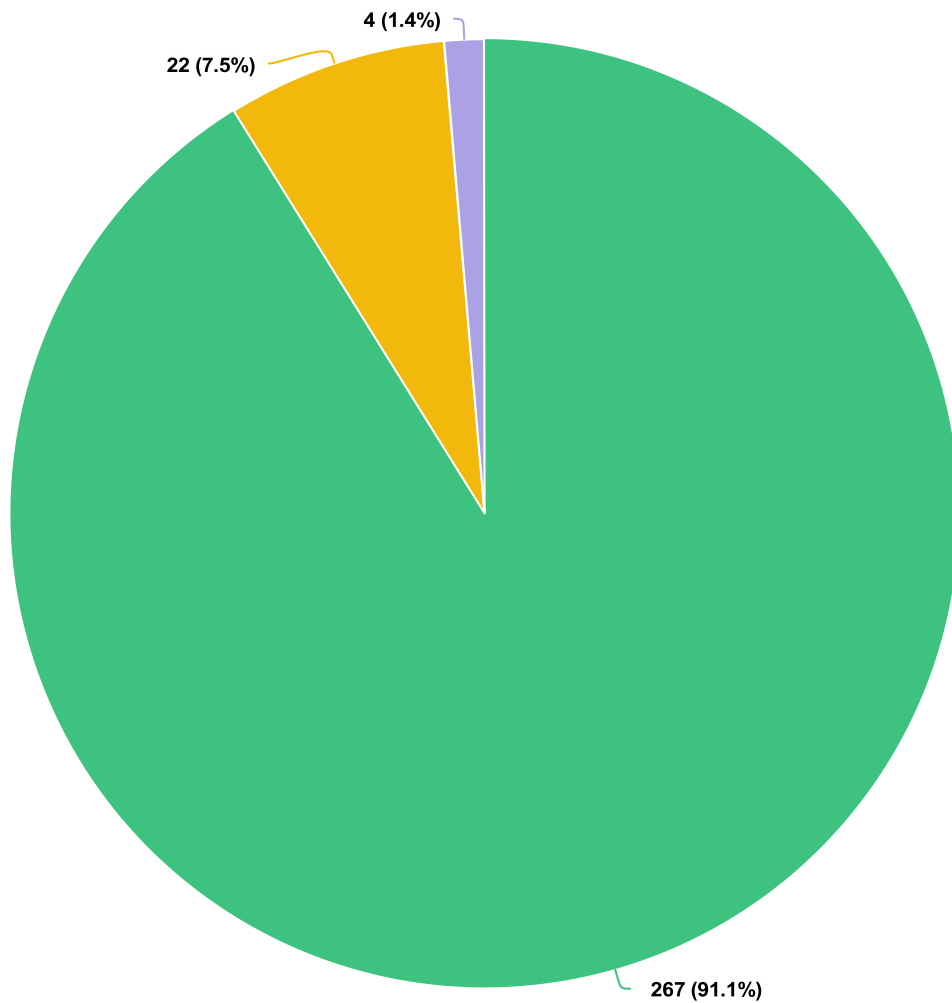

Q3 | Have you witnessed anti social behaviour linked to the consumption of alcohol in public spaces?

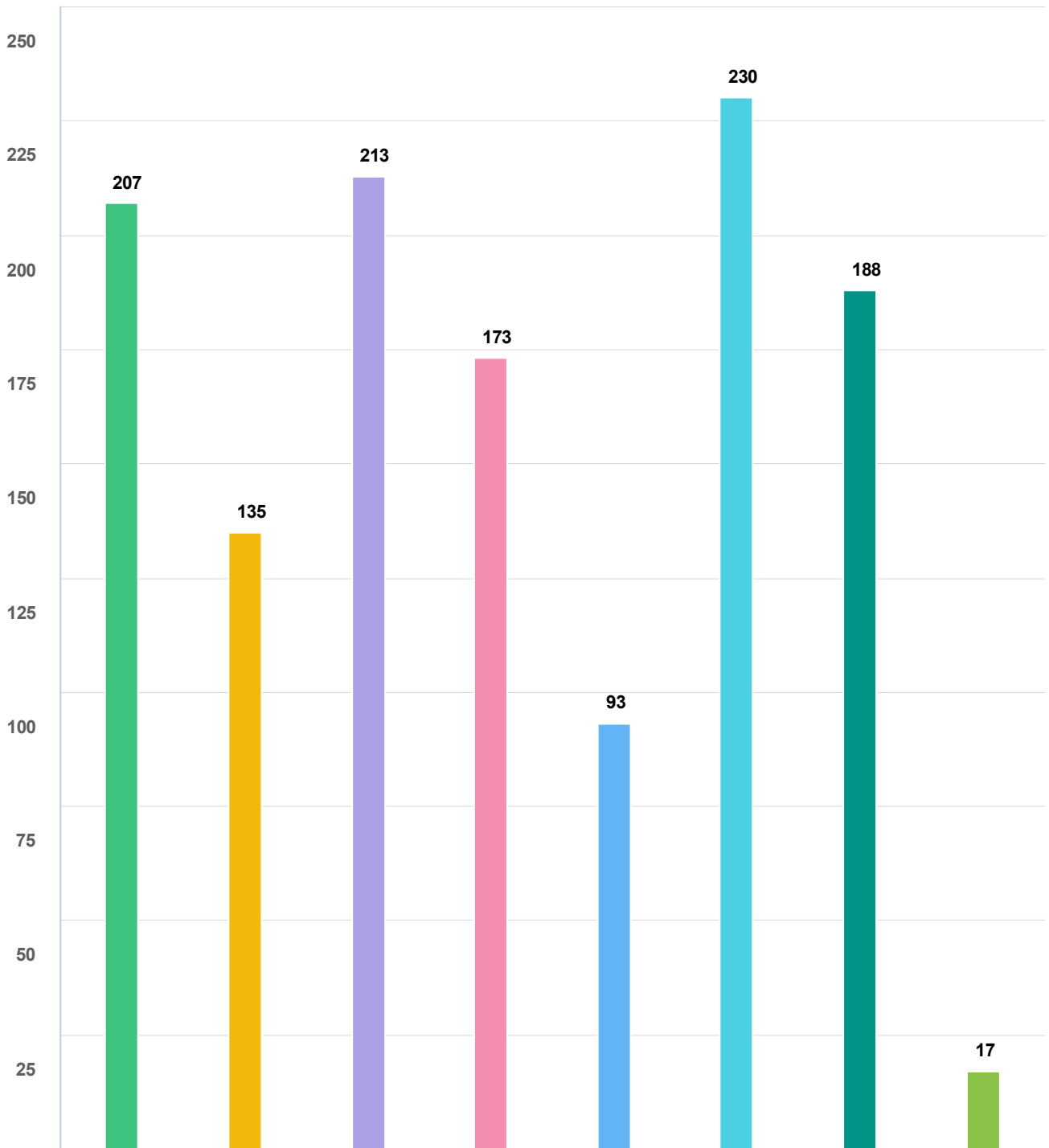

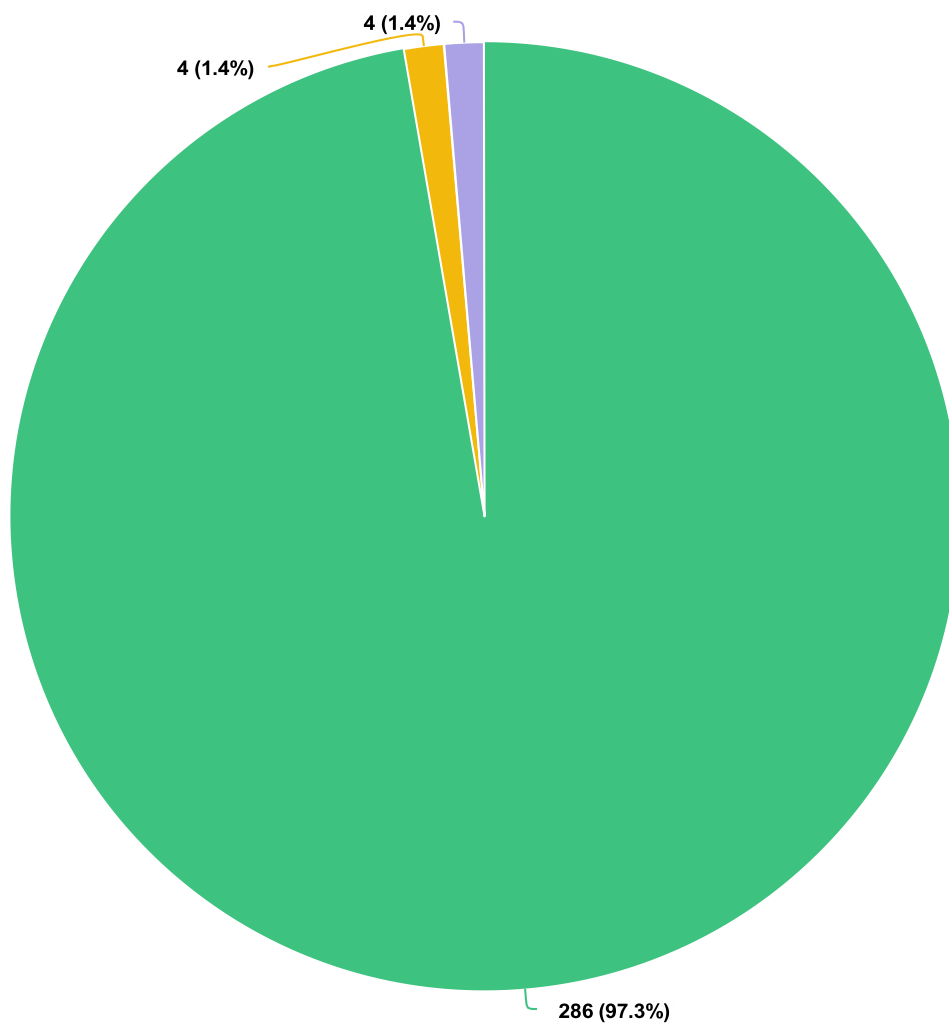

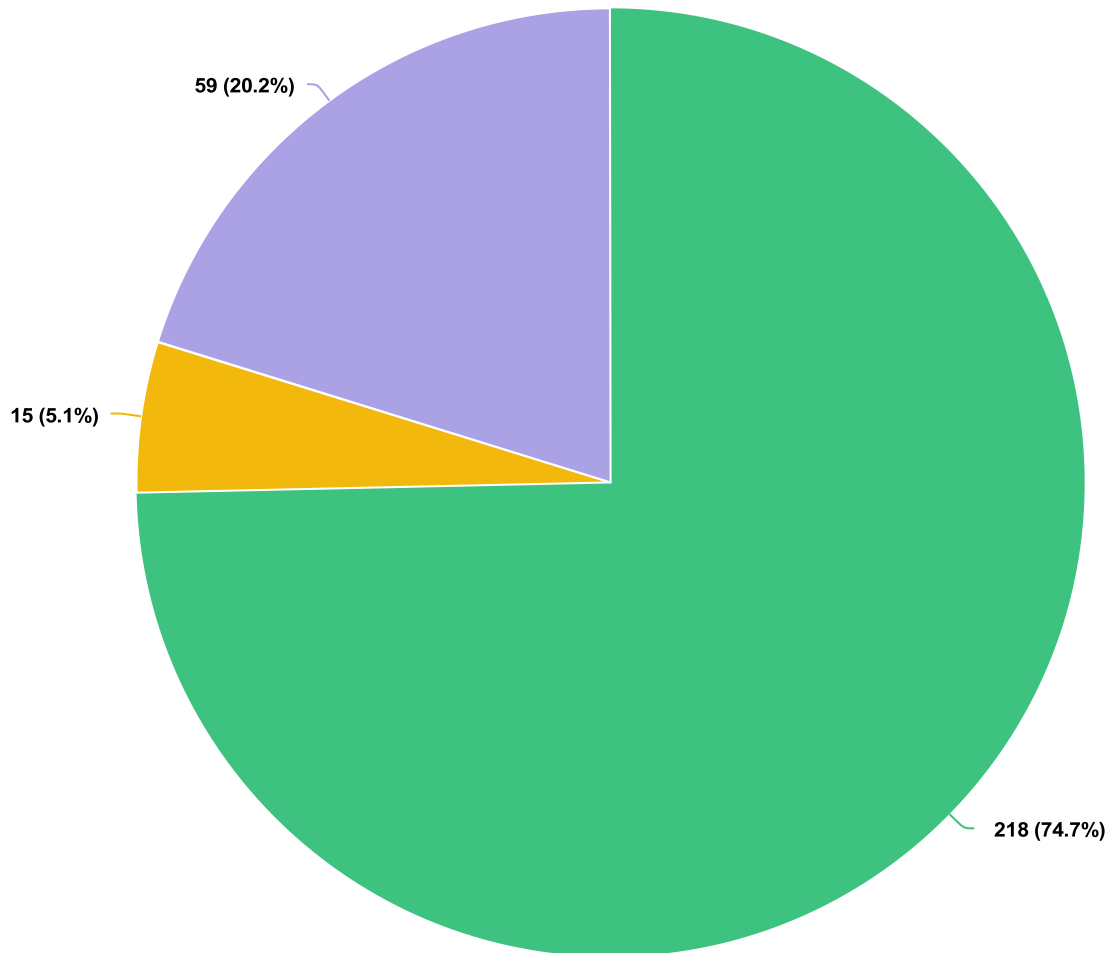

Q7 | Do you think the unauthorised use of off road motorbikes is a problem in Coventry?



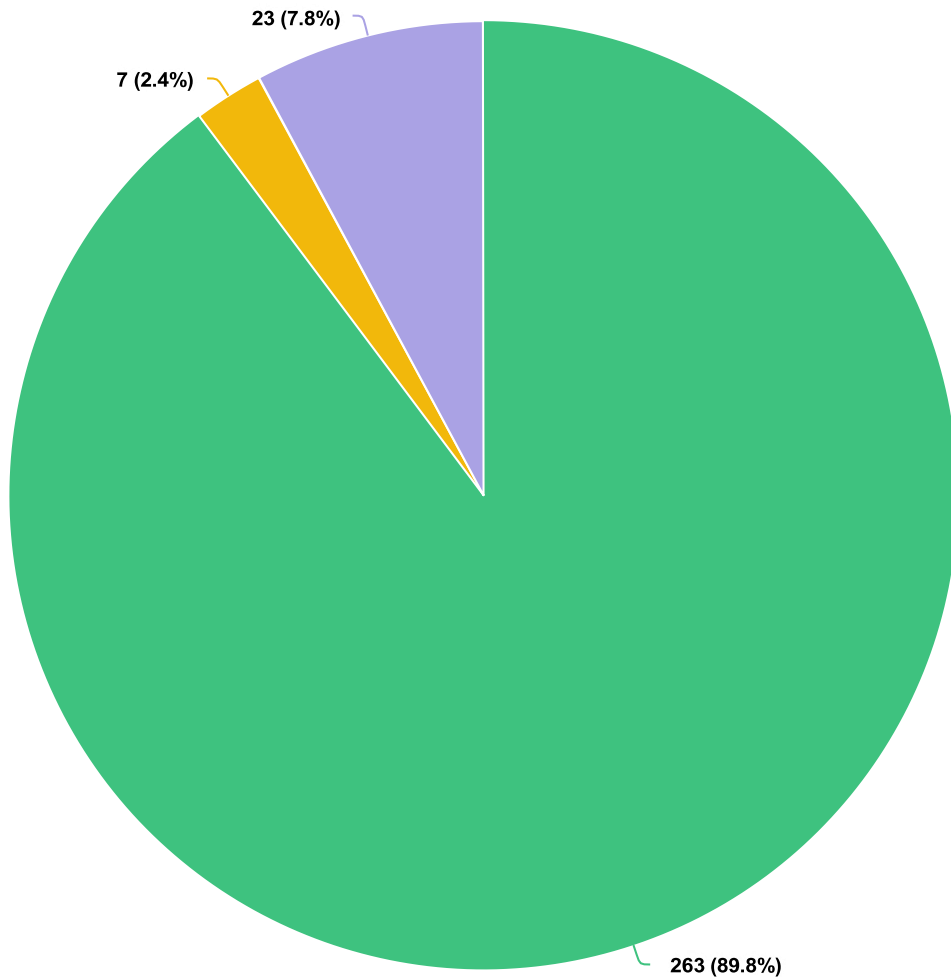

Q8 | Do you think the Council is right to refuse permission for off road bikes to use their land in the City?

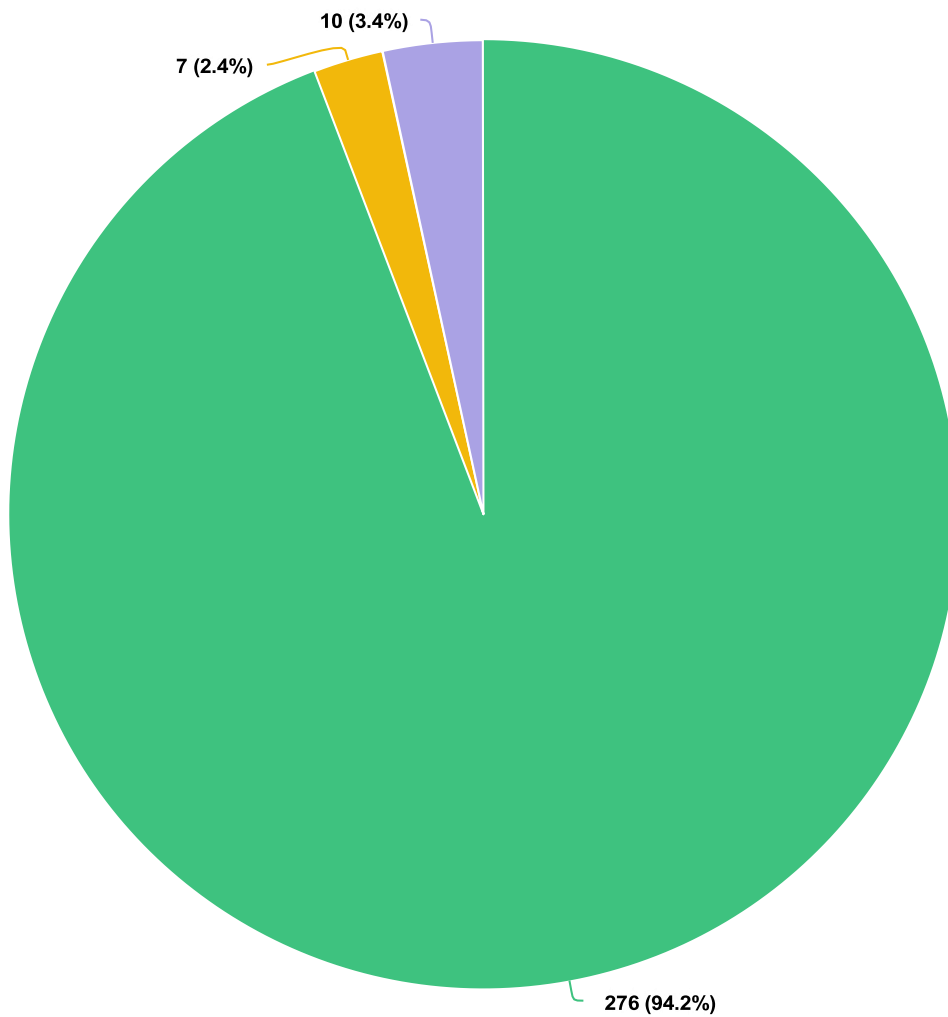

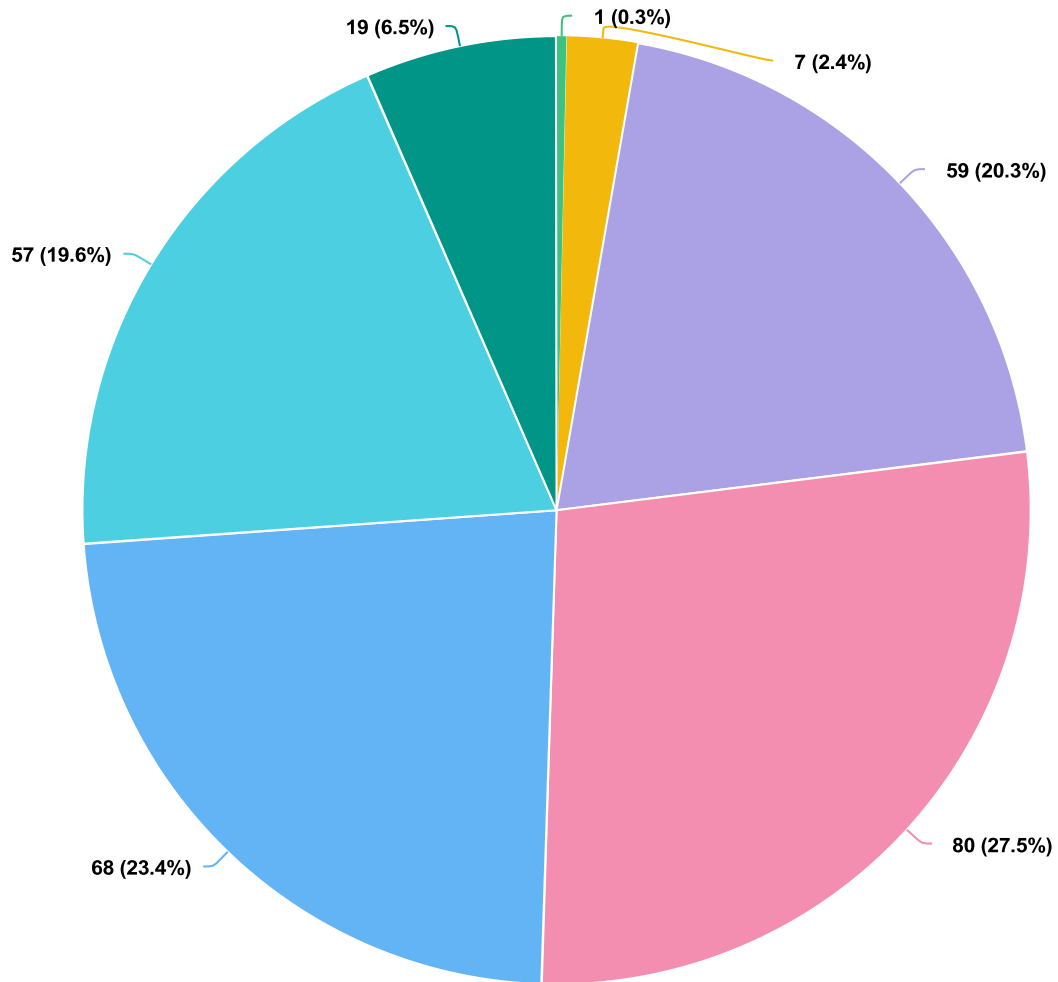

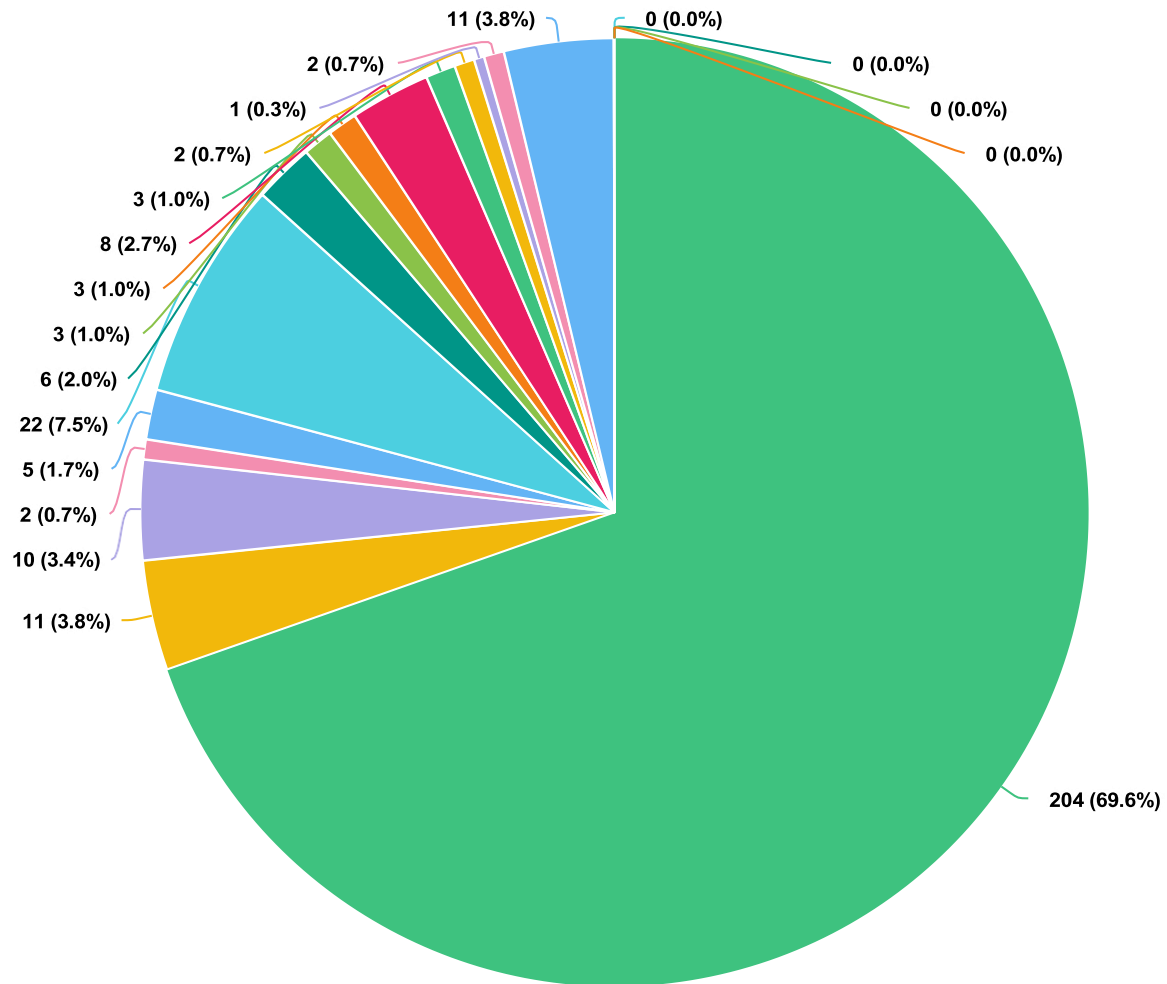

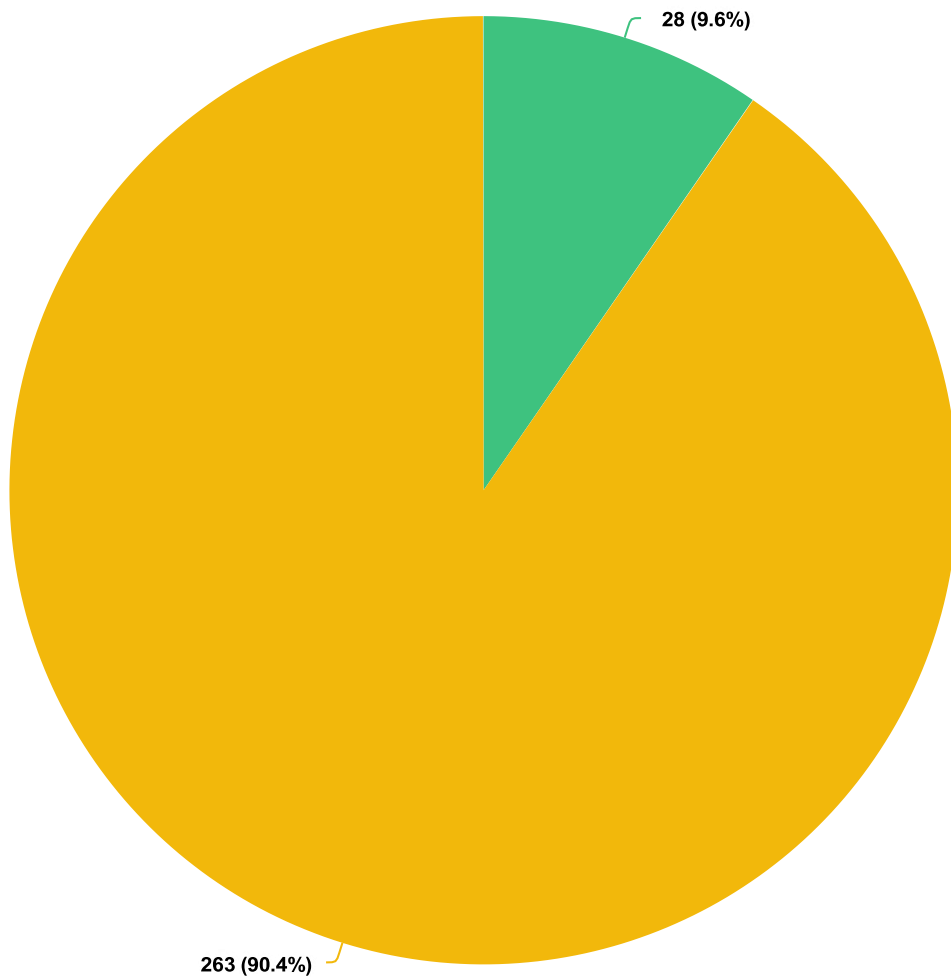
