Comment: Objection

As a consultee in assisting the licensing authority in carrying out one its four statutory objectives under The Licensing Act 2003; the Environmental Protection Department **object** to the granting of the TEN; in order to prevent public nuisance for the following reasons:-

1. On the 2nd of November 2022, an officer from the Environmental Protection Department at Coventry City Council served noise abatement notices under Sections 79 (1)(g) and 80 of the Environmental Protection Act (EPA) 1990 on The Premises Licence Holder (PLH) (Varinder Kullar) as well as the Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) (Mr Anthanasios Staikos) of the Kasbah Nightclub, Primrose Hill Street, Coventry, CV1 5LY requiring the immediate abatement of loud music from the premises.
2. On 26th May 2024, at 20:40 hrs Coventry City Council's Street Enforcement monitoring service received a telephone call from a local resident complaining of loud music noise nuisance coming from the Kasbah Nightclub. The officer who attended reported that he witnessed loud music coming from the Kasbah which was causing a statutory noise nuisance.
3. On 13th July 2024 at 19:31 hrs Coventry City Council's Street Enforcement monitoring service received a telephone call from a local resident complaining of loud music noise nuisance coming from the Kasbah Nightclub. The officer who attended reported that he witnessed loud music coming from the outdoor area of the Kasbah which was causing a statutory noise nuisance.

The noise witnessed on both the 26th May 2024 and the 13th July 2024, were considered to be at a level that constituted a statutory nuisance; which are both breaches of the Noise Abatement Notice which was served under Sections 79 (1)(g) and 80 of the Environmental Protection Act (EPA) 1990, on 2nd November 2022.
