**NOTIFICATION OF FINAL DETERMINATION OF PETITION**

The above petition was considered by the Cabinet Member (Neighbourhood Action, Housing, Leisure and Culture) on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2012. The decision is outlined below:

**The Cabinet Member (Neighbourhood Action, Housing, Leisure and Culture) approved that Officers continue dialogue with developers and local residents to ensure public art is put in place which commemorates the former land use.**
