Title:

Request by Culture Coventry Trust to Dispose of Collection Items, in Line with Relevant Policies and Accreditation Standards

Is this a key decision?

No. The subject matter within the report can affect all wards in the city, but it is not anticipated that the impact on people living and working in the area will be significant and it is therefore not deemed to be a key decision.

Executive summary:

Large municipal organisations such as Coventry City Council collect a wide range of historical and artistic artefacts over time, through a combination of statutory archiving, donations and gifts, bequests, loans, commissions, and purchases. In Coventry, a significant proportion of these items are on loan, entrusted to the care of Culture Coventry Trust by way of a Funding and Management Agreement entered-into with the Council (the "Agreement") and principally housed in Coventry Transport Museum, the Herbert Art Gallery and Museum, and in ancillary stores. For one or more reasons, including the proactive management of collections in accordance with the requirements of Accreditation, a museum may plan to periodically review such arrangements and propose to dispose of certain items from the collections in its care.

It is a requirement of the national Arts Council England (ACE) scheme for granting Accredited status to museums that participating local authorities and museums have a collections and development policy for their collections. With respect to disposals, the Culture Coventry Trust Collections Development Policy 2024-2027 sets out the principles that will provide the governing bodies (including the City Council) and the workforce of the city's museums with a framework for the responsible and ethical disposal of collections. It provides clear procedures and decision-making processes common to Accredited Museums. The policy enables the city's museums to demonstrate the public benefit in their approach to collections development. It provides a basis for open and transparent decision-making and an informed dialogue between governing bodies, donors, funding bodies and other stakeholders.

In line with the procedures set out in the Culture Coventry Trust Collection Development Policy, approval is sought from the City Council for the disposal of the 588 identified collections items set out

in this report (this figure comprising individual items and small collections), as requested by Culture Coventry.

Recommendations:

The Cabinet Member for Housing and Communities is recommended:

- (1) To approve the request by Coventry Culture Trust to dispose of 588 identified collections items, in line with relevant policies and accreditation standards.
- (2) To approve that the proceeds received from any commercial sales of disposed items be held in reserves by Culture Coventry Trust, pending re-investment into further acquisitions for the museum collections or in exceptional cases, improvements relating to the care of existing collections, in accordance with the Trust's Collections Development Policy 2024-2027.
- (3) To delegate authority to the Director of Regeneration & Economy or his nominee to oversee the appropriate disposal of collection items by Culture Coventry Trust according to accreditation standards and guidelines following disposal approval.

Report title:

Request by Culture Coventry Trust to dispose of collection items, in line with relevant policies and accreditation standards.

1. Context (or background)

- 1.1 Large municipal organisations such as Coventry City Council collect a wide range of historical and artistic artefacts over time, through a combination of statutory archiving, donations and gifts, bequests, loans, commissions, and purchases. In Coventry the significant proportion of these items are on loan, entrusted to the care of Culture Coventry Trust by way of a Funding and Management Agreement entered into with the Council (the "Agreement") and principally housed at Coventry Transport Museum, the Herbert Art Gallery and Museum, and in ancillary stores. For one or more reasons, including the proactive management of collections in accordance with the requirements of Accreditation, a museum may plan to periodically review such arrangements and propose to dispose of certain items from the collections in its care.
- 1.2 It is a requirement of Arts Council England's (ACE) Accreditation scheme that Culture Coventry has a Collections Development Policy as part of the conditions laid down for granting Accredited Status to museums. Accreditation is a nationally recognised standard for Museums.
- 1.3 The national guidance for collections development policies is developed by ACE and the provisions of their template policy must be closely adhered to by organisations in order to achieve/maintain Museum Accreditation status. This guidance includes the procedure to follow in the disposal of items from museum collections, contained within the 'Spectrum Standards on Deaccessioning and disposal' (Appendix 9)
- 1.4 The Collections Development Policy (Appendix 8) sets out the principles that will provide the governing bodies and the workforce of museums with a framework for responsible and ethical acquisition and disposal of collections. It provides clear procedures and decision-making processes common to Accredited Museums. The policy enables museums to demonstrate the public benefit in their approach to collections development. It provides a basis for open and transparent decision-making and an informed dialogue between governing bodies (including the Council), donors, funding bodies and other stakeholders.
- 1.5 Culture Coventry Trust has made a request (in accordance with the provision of the Agreement) to Coventry City Council for the disposal of 588 items managed within the current collection. The Council ensures that the Culture Coventry Trust's disposal process is carried out openly, with transparency and following the disposal procedures outlined in the Collections Development Policy 2024-2027. The items proposed for disposal are detailed in Appendices 1-7, and summarized as follows:
 - Assorted 'Large Items' 45 individual items or small collections of multiple items
 - Photographs and photographic accessories 247 individual items or small collections of multiple items
 - Retail items 33 individual items or small collections of multiple items
 - Local ceramics 84 individual items or small collections of multiple items
 - Foodstuffs 7 individual items
 - Commemorative ceramics 94 individual items or small collections of multiple items
 - Tools 78 individual items or small collections of multiple items
- 1.6 By definition, Culture Coventry Trust has a long-term purpose and holds collections in trust in relation to their stated objectives. The governing body therefore accepts the principle that sound

- curatorial reasons for disposal must be established before consideration is given to the disposal of any items in collections that are managed by the Trust.
- 1.7 The following factors (Disposal Preliminaries) must be considered before the Council agrees to dispose of any item in the collection:
 - Is the disposal motivated by curatorial reasons or financial reasons?
 - What are the proposed disposal options (gift, exchange, sale or destruction)?
 - Is Culture Coventry legally free to dispose of the object?
 - Estimated Value (where information is available according to minimum valuation thresholds)
 - Where applicable, have legal agreements with donors been considered?
 - Was the object acquired with the aid of an external funding organisation?
 - If so, have the conditions attached to the original grant been followed?
 - The full details on the curatorial reasons for disposal
- 1.8 The planned large-scale move of stored collections to the City Centre Cultural Gateway has been a stimulus for for Culture Coventry to bring forward routine reviews of the collection to ensure it is relevant, publicly accessible and aligns to the collections development policy.
- 1.9 Collection review is a crucial component to effective collection management and development, It provides an opportunity to review plans and practices relating to acquisition, disposal and loans to ensure that the collection is being used effectively for public benefit. At the same time, Culture Coventry continues to actively collect and acquire new objects.
- 1.10 Collections review is an ongoing process, and further items may be identified for disposal at a future date according to criteria identified in the Collections Development Policy.

2. Options considered and recommended proposal

- 2.1 (Option A) To approve the request by Coventry Culture Trust to dispose of 588 identified collections items, in line with relevant policies and accreditation standards; To approve the proceeds of any commercial sales of disposed items be held in reserves by Culture Coventry Trust, pending re-investment into further acquisitions for the museum collections or in exceptional cases, improvements relating to the care of existing collections, in accordance with the Trust's Collections Development Policy 2024-2027; To delegate authority the Director of Business, Investment and Culture or his nominee to oversee the appropriate disposal of collection items by Culture Coventry Trust according to accreditation standards and guidelines following disposal approval. (Recommended Option)
- 2.2 The Board of Culture Coventry Trust approved the disposal of all items listed in Appendices 1-7 for curatorial reasons at their Board meetings on **29 November 2024** (Appendices 1-5) and **28 February 2025** (Appendices 6-7). In line with the Coventry Culture Trust Collections Development Policy and the Agreement, Culture Coventry Trust is now requesting the Council's approval to dispose of these items.
- 2.3 Culture Coventry Trust have confirmed to the Council that they are legally free to dispose of items, and any agreements on disposal made with donors will be taken into account.
- 2.4 When disposal of a museum object, archive or local history item is being considered, Culture Coventry Trust establishes if it was acquired with the aid of an external funding organisation. In

- such cases, any conditions attached to the original grant will be followed. This may include repayment of the original grant and a proportion of the proceeds if the item is disposed of by sale.
- 2.5 The Council, in consultation with the curatorial team from Culture Coventry Trust, are comfortable that the Disposal Preliminaries for each artefact listed have been met, including sound curatorial reasons for the proposed disposals (**Appendix 8** CCT Collections Development Policy).
- 2.6 If approval is given to dispose of the items, the method of disposal, whether by gift, exchange, sale or destruction (in the case of an item too badly damaged or deteriorated to be of any use for the purposes of the collections), will be the responsibility of Culture Coventry Trust in collaboration with the Council acting on the advice of professional curatorial staff and not of the curator of the collection acting alone.
- 2.7 Priority will be given to retaining the item within the public domain. It will therefore be offered in the first instance, by gift or sale, directly to other Accredited Museums likely to be interested in its acquisition.
- 2.8 If the item is not acquired by any Accredited Museums to which it was offered directly as a gift for sale, then the museum community at large will be advised of the intention to dispose of the material, normally through an announcement in the Museums Association's Museum Journal, and in other specialist journals where appropriate.
- 2.9 A period of at least two months will be allowed for an interest in acquiring the material to be expressed. At the end of this period, if no expressions of interest have been received, the museum may consider disposing of the material to other interested individuals and organisations giving priority to organisations in the public domain.
- 2.10 (Option B) To refuse the request by Culture Coventry Trust to dispose of the items and maintain them within the existing collection (Not recommended).
- 2.11 If the request for disposal of these items is refused there will be implications for Culture Coventry Trust. The Trust needs to ensure it focuses its human, spatial and financial resources on the collections that are most relevant and in appropriate condition to support its purpose as a successful arts and heritage body for Coventry. Retaining items recommended for disposal can divert resources, such as storage space and curatorial and conservation staff time and materials, to items that are either already duplicated in the collections, and/or do not support Culture Coventry's core objectives.

3. Results of consultation undertaken

- 3.1 Once disposal of a museum item has been agreed by all parties, Culture Coventry is required to follow a consultation process which abides by guidelines laid down in SPECTRUM, the UK Museum Collections Management standard (**Appendix 9** Spectrum Standards on Deaccessioning and disposal).
- 3.2 This standard expects that, where items approved for disposal have not been transferred through a direct approach to a specific professional organisation, they are advertised through professional channels to enable other Accredited Museums, and relevant community organisations, to register their interest.
- 3.3 An advertisement is placed in an appropriate professional publication (for example the UK Museums Journal and/or Museums Association 'Find an Object' service) where the disposed

- object can be offered to recognised organisations. A minimum period of two months is given for an interest in acquiring the material to be expressed.
- 3.4 If there is no interest by a registered organisation in acquiring the object, it may be offered to relevant community organisations which may be able to use the item(s) for public benefit.
- 3.5 If no interest is registered, the item will be disposed of by whatever means the Culture Coventry Trust curatorial team deems most appropriate.
- 3.6 In all instances, the proceeds of any sale of items must benefit the collections. In any uncertainty around the ethics and proper procedure for commercial sale or destruction of an item, advice on these cases should be sought from the Museums Association, Arts Council England or relevant funding body as appropriate.

4. Timetable for implementing this decision

- 4.1 Following approval to dispose, Culture Coventry Trust will place details of items for disposal on the Museum Association's 'Find An Object' website; direct emails will be sent to Accredited Museums where disposals might be most relevant to their collection(s); items deemed to be in too poor a condition for display or resale and/or with health & safety implications will be disposed of appropriately.
- 4.2 A period of at least two months will be allowed for interested parties to claim items featured on the Museum Association's website or offered via direct email contact.
- 4.3 After this period, unclaimed disposals will be considered for disposal through sale (for example vehicle auction), by gift to an organisation which is not an Accredited Museum, or the item may be destroyed.

5. Comments from the Director of Finance and Resources (Section 151 Officer) and the Director of Law and Governance

5.1. Financial Implications

- 5.1.1 Costs of disposal will be met by sale proceeds, where generated. Culture Coventry Trust will undertake the disposal of items, should the recommendations of the report be agreed. The items being disposed of will not affect previous grant income received and therefore no financial risk exists to the Council from disposing of the assets. Culture Coventry Trust will need to adhere to the disposal process to ensure other risks (as outlined in the risk section below) are mitigated.
- 5.1.2 Any monies received by the Trust from the disposal of items will be applied for the benefit of the collections. This normally means the purchase of further acquisitions for the museum collections. In exceptional cases, this may include improvements relating to the care of collections in order to meet or exceed Accreditation requirements.
- 5.1.3 The proceeds from a sale will be held in reserves as restricted funds by Culture Coventry Trust, pending re-investment into further acquisitions for the museum collections. It can then be demonstrated that proceeds are spent in a manner compatible with the requirements of the Accreditation standard. Detail on the use of the proceeds will be monitored by the Council at scheduled quarterly strategic meetings between the organisations; any significant sale proceeds will be considered for their best use at time of receipt.

5.2. Legal Implications

There are no legal implications arising from this report. The proposed disposal is being undertaken in accordance with the provisions of the Agreement currently in place between the Council and Culture Coventry Trust as well as the Collection Development Policy referred to in this report.

Furthermore, Culture Coventry Trust have established that the 'Disposals Preliminaries' processes for each artefact listed in Appendices 1-7 have been met, including sound curatorial reasons for the proposed disposals.

6. Other implications

6.1. How will this contribute to the One Coventry Plan

- Working together to improve our city and the lives of those who live, work and study here –
 by ensuring resources are focussed on the conservation and interpretation of the most
 relevant and accessible items in the city's collections for the benefit of Coventry residents.
- Improving outcomes and tackling inequalities within our communities enhancing access
 to and focussing resources on the most relevant collections helps to secure the positive
 benefits to communities presented by the uniqueness of the city's heritage and cultural
 offer.
- Improving the economic prosperity of the city and region by rationalising collections and focussing resources on the most relevant items, Culture Coventry Trust will be able to better facilitate access to, and presentation of, the City's collections, in line with national guidance and accreditation standards.
- The Council as a partner, enabler and leader developing and supporting relationships with museum sector partners across the country by the offering of disposal items to Accredited Museums in other cities.
- Continued financial sustainability of the Council by ensuring resources continue to be focussed on the conservation and interpretation of the most relevant and accessible items in the city's collections.

6.2. How is risk being managed?

Disposals will not be undertaken to generate short-term revenue (for example to meet a budget deficit). If the Council or Culture Coventry disposed of the items to meet a budget deficit or disposed of items by sale in a manner deemed unethical, there would be a risk of Culture Coventry Trust losing Accredited Museum status. Such an eventuality could incur negative national coverage and potentially a perceived undermining of professional reputation, which could result in:

- The withdrawal of national museums from loan agreements (agreed or planned) with the City's museums.
- Limiting of the City's temporary/touring exhibition offer (due to the potential withdrawal of national partners from such loan agreements).
- Impact on visitor numbers and secondary spend, due to a reduction in the standard and profile of Culture Coventry Trust's temporary exhibition programme.
- Potential claw back of funding secured on condition of visitor footfall targets.

All disposals will be managed according to SPECTRUM standards. Full records will be kept of all decisions on disposals and the items involved, and proper arrangements made for the preservation and/or transfer, as appropriate, of the documentation relating to the items concerned.

6.3. What is the impact on the organisation?

None

6.4. Equalities / EIA?

As the recommendations do not represent any material change in access, policy or the cultural profile of the collections held by Culture Coventry Trust but instead support continued access to the diverse art and heritage collections held by the City's museums, there are no equalities considerations arising from the recommendations.

6.5. Implications for (or impact on) climate change and the environment?

None.

6.6. Implications for partner organisations?

If the request for disposal of these items is approved there will be positive implications for Culture Coventry Trust. The Trust will be in a position to focus its resources on the collections that are most conservable, relevant and publicly beneficial, to support its purpose as a successful arts and heritage body. The disposal of the items will result in resource savings in areas such as storage space, curatorial and conservation staff time and materials for items that do not support Culture Coventry's objectives.
