<p><b>TEXT OF QUESTION:</b></p> <p>“Could the Cabinet Member for Policy and Leadership tell us when he expects the independent evaluation into the City of Culture year to be published?”</p> <p><b>Answer:</b></p> <p>The release of the final evaluation report for Coventry UK City of Culture 2021 is now expected to be in the first week of October 2023.</p>

<p><b>TEXT OF QUESTION:</b></p> <p>“Could the Cabinet Member explain to residents on Bennetts Road in Bablake Ward why they have not had their bins collected for over three weeks?”.</p>	

**Answer:**

Bennetts Road South currently has roadworks on it with traffic lights. There are approximately 14 properties that are adversely affected by the roadworks, the properties on the east side of the road are fenced off by the roadworks, and the west side is being used by all the traffic.

Stopping the truck in the roadworks would be unsafe for our operatives, and there are very few suitable areas to pull over without causing issues.

The traffic lights run from Sandpits Lane up to around number 93d.

The road works are scheduled for completion in mid-June.
